

«BABY» PATTERN



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THE DESCRIPTION OF THIS DOLL IS FREE AND IT CAN BE SPREAD ON ANY SOCIAL MEDIA , BUT YOU SHOULD MENTION THE AUTHOR'S NAME

ABBREVIATIONS:

MR – magic/amigurumi ring;
CH – chain;
SC - single crochet;
DC - double crochet;
HDC - half double crochet;
INC - increase;
DEC – decrease (I use invisible decreases);
TDEC - treble decrease;
SL ST – slip stitch, connecting column;
FLO - front half loop (half loop closest to you);
BLO - back half loop (half loop farthest from you)
St – stitch, Sts - stitches

МАТЕРИАЛЫ:

- ♥ yarn “REHORKA open work” color №68 one piece (50gm/280 m);
- ♥ Aluminum wire size 1 mm (15 cm) and 2 mm (30 cm)
- ♥ scissors;
- ♥ hook 0,6 mm;
- ♥ T-shaped cotter pin 1,6x20 mm (2 pcs);
- ♥ round-shaped cotter pin 1,2x16 мм (2 pcs);
- ♥ stuffing;
- ♥ cardboard washer 15 mm (4 pcs), 6 mm (4 pcs);
- ♥ skewers of a different size.

ATTENTION!!!

All crochet takes place on the wrong side, so the doll will come out neater, especially face (if you do not know how to crochet on the wrong side, When crocheting with the above materials, your doll will be about 14 cm. Use thicker or thinner materials if you want to change the size of the doll.

In the process of crocheting, you may be faced with the fact, that the paired parts of the doll (legs, arms) could differ in lengths or thicknesses. This is due to the fact, that on different days or even within the same day, the thread tension in your hands changes. So, I advise you to crochet two paired parts of the doll in parallel (i.e. crochet several rows of one leg, then set it aside and crochet several rows of the other leg).

In this pattern, I crochet with the so-called "check marks". This crocheting comes out less dense. There is also crocheting with "crosses", it comes out denser, but, for example, it will be very difficult to embroider a face. If you crocheted toys before and noticed that your marker always goes vertically upward without deviating along the axis, then you will need inevitably to make offset loops and change the position of some increases and decreases. This is due to the fact, that in this pattern described below, marker deviates vertically and goes up in a spiral. Also, due to the offset of the marker, some increases and decreases may be located asymmetrically relative to other increases and decreases. Therefore, this should not confuse you.

P.S. I USE TWO SIZE OF THE SKEWER (THICK AND THIN). A THIN SKEWER IS MORE CONVENIENT FOR STUFFING SMALL PARTS. ALSO, FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE, I ADVISE YOU TO BREAK OFF THE TIPS OF BOTH SKEWERS, SO IT WILL BE EASIER TO TAMP THE STUFFING.

ARMS

RIGHT ARM:

- 1) 4 CH, 3 sl st. (3)
- 2) 5 CH, 4 sl st. (4)
- 3) 5 CH, 4 sl st. (4)
- 4) 5 CH, 4 sl st. (4)

The 5th row will be crocheting on the fingers.

- 5) 5 sc on one side of the fingers, (1 sc, 1 inc)*2, 1 sc. (12) - put a marker
- 6) 12 sc. (12)
- 7) (4 CH, 3 sc in chain), 12 sc.
- 8) 2 sc across the big finger, 12 sc. (14)
- 9) 9 sc, 5 sc in FLO. (14)
- 10) 1 dec, 7 sc, (in BLO of row 9: 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc). (14)
- 11)-16) 14 sc. (14)
- 17) 4 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc. (13)
- 18)-20) 13 sc. (13)
- 21) 4 sc, 1 dec, 7 sc. (12)
- 22)-23) 12 sc. (12)
- 24) 4 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc. (11)
- 25)-26) 11 sc. (11)
- 27) 5 sc, 1 CH, skip 1 st, 5 sc. (11)

Put the cotter pin 1,2x16mm with a 6 mm cardboard washer in the skipped st of the row 27. Measure the arm and cut the wire (size 1 mm), and put it inside of the arm. Stuff the arm.

- 28) 3 dec, 1 sc, 2 dec. (6)

Close the remaining hole.

LEFT ARM:

- 1) 5 CH, 4 sl st. (4)
- 2) 5 CH, 4 sl st. (4)
- 3) 5 CH, 4 sl st. (4)
- 4) 4 CH, 3 sl st. (3)

The 5th row will be crocheting on the fingers.

- 5) 5 sc on one side of the fingers, (1 sc, 1 inc)*2, 1 sc. (12) -put the marker
- 6) 12 sc. (12)
- 7) 5 sc, (4 CH, 3 sc in chain), 7 sc. (12)
- 8) 5 sc, 2 sc across the big finger, 7 sc. (14)
- 9) 8 sc, 5 sc in FLO, 1 sc. (14)
- 10) 6 sc, 1 dec, (in BLO of row 9: 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc), 1 sc. (14)
- 11)-16) 14 sc. (14)
- 17) 3 sc, 1 dec, 9 sc. (13)
- 18)-20) 13 sc. (13)
- 21) 3 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc. (12)
- 22)-23) 12 sc. (12)
- 24) 3 sc, 1 dec, 7 sc. (11)
- 25)-26) 11 sc. (11)
- 27) 4 sc, 1 CH, skip 1 st, 6 sc. (11)

Put the cotter pin 1,2x16mm with a 6 mm cardboard washer in the skipped st of the row 27. Measure the arm and cut the wire (size 1 mm), and put it inside of the arm. Stuff the arm.

- 28) 2 dec, 1 sc, 3 dec. (6)

Close the remaining hole.

LEGS

LEFT LEG:

Before you begin to crochet the leg, cut the thread 50 cm long, it will be used for the heel.

The leg begins with a toes, which are crocheted the same way as fingers. If it will be difficult to crochet such a tiny toes, then you can begin to crochet the feet with a chain and 15 sc in it (you should decide yourself how many CH you will need to fit there 15 sts).

- 1) 3 CH, 2 sc. (2) - **big toe**
- 2) 4 CH, 2 sl st. (2) - **1 CH left not worked.**
- 3) 3 CH, 2 sl st. (2)
- 4) 3 CH, 2 sl st. (2)
- 5) 2 CH, 1 sl st. (1)

Crochet row 6 the same way as the row 5 for the fingers.

- 6) 7 сбн on one side of the fingers, 1 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc. (15) - **put the marker**
- 7) - 9) 15 sc. (15)
- 10) 3 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc, 6 sc in FLO. (14)

Take a piece of thread you cut at the beginning, count 2 sts from the end of the row 10 and attach the thread in the 3rd st. Crochet the heel.

HEEL: 1) - 4) 4 sc, CH, turn. (4)

Back to the main thread.

11) 1 dec, 3 sc on one side of the heel, (on the top: 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc), 3 sc on the other side of the heel, 1 dec, (in BLO of row 10: 1 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc). (19)

- 12) 19 sc. (19)
- 13) 5 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc. (19)
- 14) 5 sc, 2 inc in BLO, 12 sc. (21)
- 15) - 18) 21 sc. (21)
- 19) 5 sc, 2 dec, 12 sc. (19)
- 20) 4 sc, 5 sc in FLO, 5 sc, (in BLO: 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc), 2 sc. (21)
- 21) 4 sc, (in BLO of row 20: 2 inc, 1 sc, 2 inc), 12 sc. (25)
- 22) 6 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc)*2, 1 inc, 7 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc. (26)
- 23) 8 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 dec. (26)
- 24) 23 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc. (25)
- 25) - 30) 25 sc. (25)
- 31) 5 sc, (1 dec, 4 sc)*2, 1 CH, skip 1 st, 5 sc, 1 dec. (22)
- 32) (4 sc, 1 dec)*2, 8 sc, 1 dec. (19)

Put the T-shaped cotter pin with the 15mm washer in the skipped at of the row 31. Cut the wire, wrap it with a tape as shown in the video. Put the wire in the leg and stuff it.

- 33) 3 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc, 1 dec. (16)
- 34) 2 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec. (13)

Make 7 dec and close the hole.

RIGHT LEG:

Cut the thread 50 cm long as for the left leg.

- 1) 2 CH, 1 sl st. (1)
- 2) 3 CH, 2 sl st. (2)
- 3) 3 CH, 3 sl st. (2)
- 4) 3 CH, 2 sl st. (2)
- 5) 4 CH, 2 sc. (2) - **1 CH left not worked**
- 6) 7 sc on one side of the fingers, (1 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc). (15) - **put the marker**

- 7) -9) 15 sc. (15)
10) 3 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc, 6 sc in FLO. (14)

Take a piece of thread you cut at the beginning, count 2 sts from the end of the row 10 and attach the thread in the 3rd st. Crochet the heel.

Back to the main thread.

- 11) 1 dec, 3 sc on one side of the heel, (on the top: 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc), 3 sc on the other side of the heel, 1 dec, (in BLO of row 10: 1 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc) (19)
12) 19 sc. (19)
13) 5 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc. (19)
14) 5 sc, 2 inc in BLO, 12 sc. (21)
15) -18) 21 sc. (21)
19) 5 sc, 2 dec, 12 sc. (19)
20) 4 sc, 5 sc in FLO, 6 sc, (in BLO: 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc), 1 sc. (21)
21) 4 sc. (in BLO of row 20: 2 inc, 1 sc, 2 inc), 12 sc. (25)
22) 6 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc)*2, 1 inc, 8 sc, (1 dec, 1 sc)*2. (26)
23) 8 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 dec. (26)
24) 23 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc. (25)
25) -30) 25 sc. (25)
31) 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 CH, skip 1 st, (4 sc, 1 dec)*2, 5 sc. (22) 32) 1 dec, 8 sc, (1 dec, 4 sc)*2. (19)

Put the T-shaped cotter pin with the 15mm washer in the skipped at of the row 31. Cut the wire, wrap it with a tape as shown in the video. Put the wire in the leg and stuff it.

- 33) 1 dec, 6 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc. (16)
34) 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc. (13)

Make 7 dec and close the hole.

BODY

- 2) 6 inc. (12)
- 3) (1 inc, 1 sc)*6. (18)
- 4) (1 inc, 2 sc)*6. (24)
- 5) (1 inc, 3 sc)*6. (30)
- 6) 1 sc, 4 inc, 7 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc, 7 sc, 4 inc, 1 sc. (40)
- 7) 40 sc. (40)
- 8) 1 sc, (1 sc, 1 inc)*3, 9 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc, 9 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc)*3, 1 sc. (48)
- 9) 13 sc, 1 CH, skip 1 st, 20 sc, 1 CH, skip 1 st, 13 sc. (48)
- 10) 19 sc, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 inc, 19 sc. (50)

Put the cotter pins from the legs in the skipped sts of the row 9. Take 2 washers size 15 mm and put them on the cotter pins ends from inside of the body and roll the ends of cotter pins with a round nose pliers. Tighten the ends of the cotter pins very hard to fix the legs as tight as it possible.

Put the cotter pins ends from the arms in the skipped sts of the row 24. Put the 6 mm washers on the other ends of the cotter pin from inside of the body and fix them.

- 27) 7 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc. (33)
- 28) 6 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc. (29)
- 29) (5 sc, 1 dec)*2, 6 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec. (25)
- 30) 7 sc, 2 dec, 8 sc, 2 dec, 2 sc. (21)

Measure and cut the wire approximately 11 cm. Bend it and wrap it with a tape as shown in the video. Put the wire inside of the body and stuff it tight.

- 32) 10 dec, skip 1 st. (10) -stuff it
- 33)-51) 10 sc. (10) - **190 sts in total**

Cut the thread, close the remaining hole.

- 7) 7 sc, 1 inc, 7 sc, 3 sc in one st, 7 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc. (34)
- 8) 7 sc, 1 inc, 9 sc, 3 sc in one st, 9 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc. (38)
- 9) 7 sc, 1 inc, 11 sc, 3 sc in one st, 11 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc. (42)
- 10) 7 sc, 1 inc, 13 sc, 3 sc in one st, 13 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc. (46)

Tuck inside of the head first 4 rows. Put the head on the skewer of the neck. Stuff it tight.

- 44) (1 dec, 1 sc)*5. (10) - stuff it
- 45) 5 dec. (5)

Cut the thread, close the remaining hole.

LIPS:

Cut 2 pieces of thread 30 cm long each. Attach the first thread for BLO of the row 15 (as shown in the video), make CH and in the next st you **work: 1 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc, sl st.**

Then attach the second thread for the BLO of the row 14, make CH and in the next st work: **3 sc, sl st.**

Lead the ends of the threads to the hole under the chin, tight them and cut the excess.

EARs:

Use the same pattern below for both ears.

- 1) in MR: 1 hdc, 7 dc, 1 sc, CH, turn. (9)
- 2) sl st, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 dcINC, 2 hdc, 1 sc, sl st. (10)

Leave the tips of the threads 5 cm long to use them later to attach the ears to the head. It is better to attach the ears after you embroider the face.
