Bills Used in Scoring

SB23 | 6 Week Abortion Ban - criminalizing abortion after a detectable fetal heartbeat, which can occur as early as 6 weeks into pregnancy. House vote: 4/10/2019. Innovation Ohio supports a NO vote on the legislation.

HB154 | Eliminate Academic Distress Commissions - ends the controversial practice of placing local school districts under state control as a result of low test scores and replaces it with a requirement for local improvement plans. House vote: 5/1/2019. Innovation Ohio supports a YES vote on the legislation.

HB6 | Nuclear Bailout/End Renewable Targets - creates a new fee on utility bills to support a bailout of failing power plants, including two operated by Energy Harbor (formerly FirstEnergy Solutions) and ends the state's groundbreaking renewable energy and efficiency targets. House vote: 7/23/19. Innovation Ohio supports a NO vote on the legislation.

HB144 | Ban Mandatory Nursing Overtime - prohibits a hospital from requiring a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse to work overtime as a condition of employment. House vote: 12/11/19. Innovation Ohio supports a YES vote on the legislation.

HB242 | Prohibit Local Plastic Bag Limits - prohibits local governments from enacting fees on or prohibitions against the use of single-use plastic containers. House vote: 12/11/19. Innovation Ohio supports a NO vote on the legislation.

SB1 | Limit Health Director Powers - limits the power of the state health director to enact public health orders over 2 weeks in duration, such as those that limited mass gatherings during the COVID-19 pandemic. House vote: 5/6/2020. Innovation Ohio supports a NO vote on the legislation.

HR342 | Require Facial Covering - mandates mask wearing by staff and members of the Ohio House in the Statehouse and associated office buildings during the COVID-19 pandemic. Motion to adopt: 5/13/20. Innovation Ohio supports a YES vote on the motion.

HB285 | Drivers License Reinstate - provides amnesty from fees for low-income Ohioans with suspended drivers licenses who have completed all court-ordered sanctions. House vote: 5/28/20. Innovation Ohio supports a YES vote on the legislation.

HB665 (Amendment) | Confederate Flag - the amendment would have blocked state funding to county fairs that allowed the sale of confederate flag merchandise and memorabilia. Motion to table amendment: 6/11/20. Innovation Ohio supports a NO vote on the motion.

HB425 (Amendment) | Safe Firearm Storage - the amendment would have required firearms to be stored safely away from minor children. Motion to table amendment: 6/11/20. Innovation Ohio supports a NO vote on the motion.

HB680 | Mail-Based Voting - this legislation prohibits the secretary of state from prepaying return postage on mail-in ballots and applications for ballots. House vote: 6/4/20. Innovation Ohio supports a NO vote on the legislation.

Floor Motion | Impeach Representative Householder - the proposal, which was tabled by a majority vote, would have begun debate on removing Larry Householder as a member of the Ohio House of Representatives. Motion to table: 7/30/20. Innovation Ohio supports a NO vote on the motion.
