

An economically strong Israel, integrated with the free world's trade, can thwart Russian aggression in the Middle East, Senator John F. Kennedy declared at a press preview of the Israel Exposition on Tuesday.

"The exhibit is impressive," the Senator said, because it shows Israel's ability and determination to overcome the great obstacle of converting from a pastural to an industrial economy.



L. Kaganovitch: Short Biography By JEWISH CHRONICLE FEATURES

The reconstruction of the Soviet Government, following Stalin's death, resulted in Lazar Kaganovitch, the 59-year-old son of a Jewish shoemaker, being appointed to one of the highest posts in the Russian administration. With Malenkov as Premier, Kaganovitch has been appointed first Deputy-Premier-there are four Deputy Prime Ministers-or, to use the Russian terminology, Deputy Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the USSR. He is also one of the ten members of the reconstructed Presidium of the Communist Party.

Kaganovitch was no relation of Stalin. It is not true, as some papers reported, that Stalin married his daughter or his niece. His appointment and the honor given to him of heading the sevenmember commission charged with making the arrangements for Stalin's funeral were due to the fact that he was the dead ruler's most trusted comrade. 

Myerson, Israel Minister of Labor, will take over as head of the Israel delegation to the United Nations, it was announced here this week. She will replace Abba S. Eban, Israel Ambassador to the United States, who had filled both posts. Mr. Eban will remain in Washington.

Mrs. Myerson, who was Israel's first Minister to Moscow, will guide the presentation of charges Israel is expected to make of anti-Semitism in the Soviet Union and the satellite states in the current General Assembly session. The debate on this question is expected to begin next week under the terms of a generally worded Polish proposal to consider measures to "strengthen peace and friendship among the

NEW YORK (JTA) - Dispatches received here this week by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency from its correspondents at numerous points along the Iron Curtain unfolded a pattern of growing panic and terror among the Jews in Communist-ruled territory. In Communist-dominated Hun-

gary, Vienna dispatches reported, deportation of Jews from their homes has been extended to a number of military and industrial centers and from areas along the Czechoslovak, Yugoslav, Austrian and Rumanian frontiers.

The deported Jews are sent into the interior of the country to work on farms and labor projects. There they must report regularly to special police authorities. Most of them are ordered to leave their home towns on short notice. A careful check is made by the police whether


