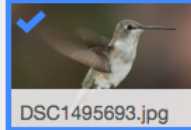

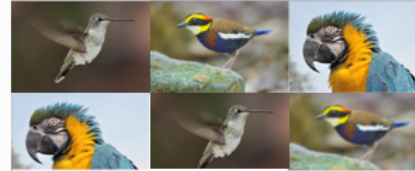

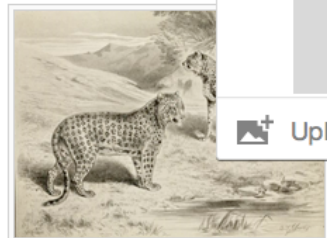

During a typical chase, its respiratory rate increases from 60 to 150 breaths per minute.<sup>[11]</sup> While running, in addition to having good traction due to its semi-retractable claws, the cheetah uses its tail as a rudder-like means of steering<sup>[citation needed]</sup> to allow it to make sharp turns, necessary to outflank prey animals that often make such turns to escape.

Its thin and fragile body make it well-suited to short bursts of high speed, but not to long-distance running.

Agility, rather than raw speed, accounts for much of the cheetah's ability to catch prey. Cheetahs can accelerate four times as fast as a human (thanks to greater muscle power) and can slow down by 14 **kilometers** per hour in one stride. They can hunt successfully in dense forests. <sup>[16]</sup>

The adult cheetah weighs from 21 to 72 kg (46 to 159 **lb**). Its total head-and-measure 60 to 84 cm (24 to 33 in) in length. <sup>[17][18][19][20]</sup> Cheetahs are 66 larger than females and have slightly bigger heads, but there is not a great apart by appearance alone. Compared to a similarly sized **leopard**, the che averages about 90 cm (35 in) tall) and so it appears more streamlined.
