Sin: I return herewith, without my approval,

5 F. No. 167, entiled "An act to vacate the village plat of Janesville,

Waseca county, State of Minnesota," and

S. F. No. 201, entitled "An act to vacate the alley through block hirty-two, in the village of Albert Lea, Freeborn county, and also part the railroad addition to the said village of Albert Lea."

Idecline to sign these two bills for the same reasons which induced to withhold my approval of those of similar character recently remed to you. A mode of procedure in the courts having been expessly provided to attain the end proposed by these bills, I think it wise all safe to refrain from legislative interference in such matters. Otherwise great injustice may be done to unnotified parties in interests, while wrong is inflicted upon those seeking this action, who have their remady by laws already in operation.
