

# An Act

S. F. No. 1067  
Chap. 426

TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR EXPENSES OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES AND PRESCRIBING PRESENT AND FUTURE REGULATIONS AND LIMITATIONS RELATIVE TO, AND THE EXPENDITURE OF CERTAIN PORTIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. The sums hereinafter set forth in the columns designated "Appropriations" or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purposes specified in the following sections of this act, to be available for the fiscal year indicated for each purpose. The figures "1929," "1930," and "1931" wherever used in this act shall mean that the appropriation, or appropriations listed thereunder shall be available for the year ending June 30, 1929, 1930 and 1931, respectively.






The Senate adopted the recommendation and report of the conference committee on S.F. No. 1067, and repassed said bill in accordance with the report of the committee so adopted.


