## REPORTS OF COMMITTEES—CONTINUED.

Mr. Ribenack, from the Committee on Cities of the First Class, to which was referred—

H. F. No. 655, A bill for an act to amend Subdivision 9, Section 1, Chapter 351, Special Laws 1889, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 362, General Laws 1921, relating to the criminal jurisdiction of the municipal court for the city of St. Paul, and to amend Section 52, Chapter 351, Special Laws 1889, as amended by Chapter 302, General Laws 1907, as amended by Chapter 430, Section 1, General Laws 1913, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 308, General Laws 1919, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 362, General Laws 1921, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 317, General Laws 1927, relating to salaries of judges of the municipal court of the city of St. Paul.

Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

Strike out lines 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23, of Section 1 of the printed bill.

And when so amended, that the bill do pass.
