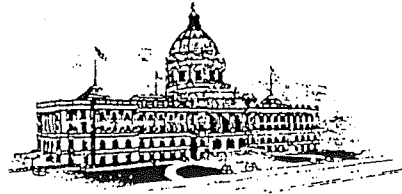

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:


12 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1990, section 326.01,
13 subdivision 2, is amended to read:


14 Subd. 2. [CLASS A MASTER ELECTRICIAN.] The term "Class A
15 master electrician" means a person having the necessary
16 qualifications, training, experience, and technical knowledge to
17 install and, alter, repair and-to-property, plan, lay out, and
18 supervise the installation installing, altering, and repairing
19 of electrical wiring, apparatus, and equipment for electric
20 light, heat, power, and other purposes who is licensed as such
21 by the state board of electricity.

22 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1990, section 326.01,
23 subdivision 3, is amended to read:


24 Subd. 3. [CLASS A JOURNEYMAN ELECTRICIAN.] The term "Class
25 A journeyman electrician" means a person having the necessary
26 qualifications, training, experience, and technical knowledge to
27 wire-for, install, and alter, repair, and supervise the
28 installing, altering, or repairing of electrical wiring,

This bill was passed in conformity to the rules of each house and the joint rules of the two houses as required by the Constitution of the State of Minnesota.


