I believe the Legislature has done a good job in recognizing the state's priority investments and limiting the overall size of this emergency bonding bill. I have respected every effort that reflects emergency projects with stateside significance, and signed into law all but one project authorized in the bill. The item that I have vetoed is:

Page 5, section 8, subdivision 3, lines 32-37.

I am vetoing the \$1,000,000 appropriation to the St. Paul Port Authority for acquisition of the Trillium site in the city of Saint Paul. This project was not pre-approved by all parties involved in negotiating a final agreement on the bill, and is not an emergency item.
