I have vetoed and am returning Senate File 284, Chapter 99, a bill applying certain privileges to major political party caucuses held in cities of the first cities during odd-numbered years.

This would allow for special privileges for caucus attendees who reside in Saint Paul, Minneapolis, and Duluth. The state should not dictate additional mandates on businesses for what is a local issue.
