## Japan Civil Aviation Bureau Airworthiness Directive

The undermentioned examinations or modifications are mandatory

- 1. Applies to: Kawasaki Hughes Model 369HS and 369D helicopters equipped with blade attaching pins, Part Number 369A1004-5, manufactured by Avibank Mfg., Inc. on and before December, 1992.
- 2. Compliance required as indicated, unless already accomplished.

To prevent fatigue cracking of main rotor blade attaching pins, accomplish the following.

- 2.1 Prior to further flight after the effective date of this AD, and thereafter at intervals not to exceed 25 flight hours since last inspection, perform repetitive inspections of the attaching pins for crack in accordance with Kawasaki Hughes 369 Service Bulletin No.KSB-369-335A dated May 15, 2000 or No.KSB-369D-216A dated May 15, 2000 or further JCAB approved revisions. If any discrepancy is found, replace the attaching pin with a serviceable one.
- 2.2 The attaching pins, which are stored as spares, shall be inspected in accordance with the paragraph 2.1 of this AD before they are installed in the helicopter.
- 2.3 An alternative means of compliance with this AD may be used, if approved by the Director-General of JCAB.

## 3. Remarks

- 3.1 This AD becomes effective on June 28, 2000.
- 3.2 This AD revises AD 5160-99 dated November 26, 1999.
- 3.3 Kawasaki Hughes 369 Service Bulletin No.KSB-369-335A and No.KSB-369D-216A dated May 15, 2000, and further JCAB approved revisions pertain to this subject.
