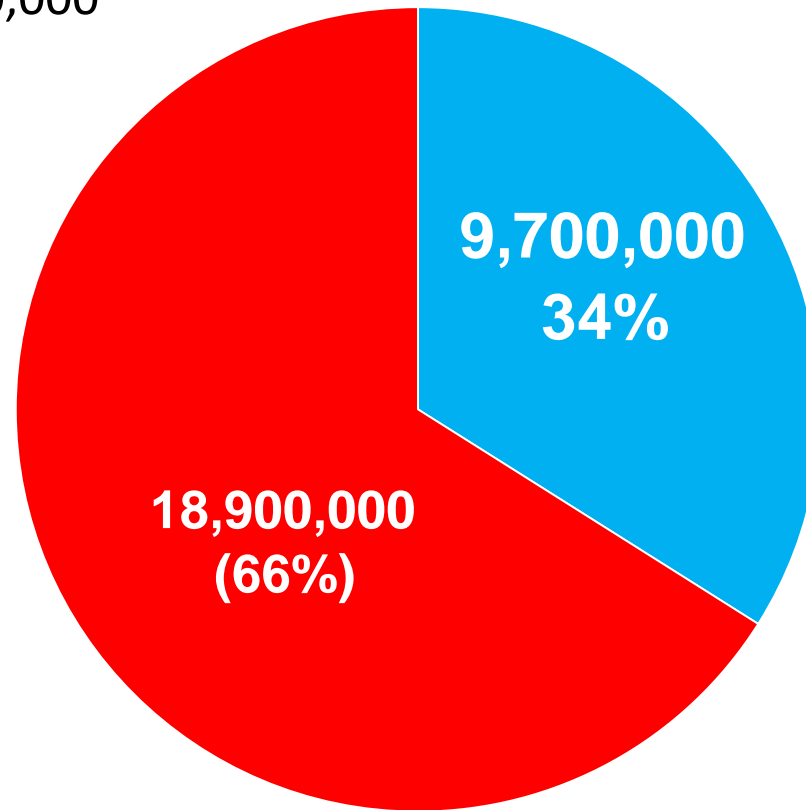


Global antiretroviral coverage 2012 (WHO 2013 guidelines)

Total eligible: 28,600,000



- Eligible and receiving treatment

FOCUS: Key populations are more likely to be living with HIV than general population
