ABOUT KNX

Unlike proprietary systems, KNX is an open worldwide standard with over 500 manufacturers across 45 countries producing 8,000 products that all interoperate together for a seamless home and building automation solution encompassing control over lighting, shutters, security systems, HVAC, and energy management. All aspects of KNX are managed by the KNX Association (est. 1999) in Brussels.

All KNX products are programmed on the KNX ETS software used by more than 120,000 installers worldwide. KNX integrates with all leading AV control systems (RTI, Crestron, AMX, Control4, Q-SYS, Savant etc), along with DALI, BACnet, Modbus, and others.



KNX IN AUSTRALIA

The KNX Protocol was adopted by Standards Australia in 2018 (SA/SNZ ISO/IEC TS 14543.3.1-6:2018 Technical Specification). Over 450 Australians have completed their KNX Certification since its introduction here. KNX is the future of home and building automation in Australia.
