On Sunday, May 19, 2024, at approximately 5:44 p.m., Eules Police responded to an apartment complex pool in the 2500 block of Highway 360 regarding a disturbance between two women.

Upon arrival, officers were told by witnesses that a woman who was very intoxicated had tried to drown a child and argued with the child's mother. Officers contacted the woman who was identified as 42-year-old Elizabeth Wolf as she tried to leave. Wolf was placed under arrest for Public Intoxication.

Officers continued their investigation at the scene and spoke to the mother of the victims. The 32-year-old mother stated that Wolf had been questioning where she was from and if the two children playing at the pool were hers. When the mother answered her, she stated that Wolf tried to grab her 6-year-old son but he pulled away from her grasp which caused a scratch on his finger. The mother began helping her son when Wolf grabbed her 3-year-old daughter and forced her underwater. The mother was able to pull her daughter from the water. Her daughter had been yelling for help and was coughing up water. Eules Medics responded to the scene to evaluate both children. Both children were medically cleared.

The mother of the two children stated that Wolf made statements about her not being an American and other racial statements. Eules Detectives took statements from the mother of the victims and the witnesses at the scene.

Wolf was charged with Attempted Capital Murder and Injury to a Child. The cases were accepted by the Tarrant County District Attorney's Office.
