SCALING HEIGHTS

Exciting Vision 2033 achievements accelerated the spread of God's Word in fiscal year 2024. On the climb to record and freely provide God's Word in every language that needs it by 2033, Faith Comes By Hearing scaled thrilling heights—to the glory of God.

Highlights

- We surpassed an amazing **2,000 language communities** to receive God's Word in audio by way of field, virtual, partner, and OBT recording projects.
- Digital Scripture engagement exceeded one billion chapters accessed.
- Advances in technology paved the way for Render 3, a vital software upgrade for Oral Bible Translation.
- In collaboration with Bible Media Group (BMG), we celebrated **the release of The Covenant film**, a word-for-word portrayal of key Old Testament passages that Faith Comes By Hearing and BMG have adapted with Scripture recordings in 63 languages and counting.

Africa

One of Faith Comes By Hearing's partners took a Proclaimer along on a medical mission trip and spent a month with the Pokot community of Kenya. People in need of clinical attention flocked to the mobile care centers set up on the journey. As they waited to be seen or rested after treatment, the audible Word of God played. One gentleman cradled the Proclaimer in his arms as he recovered. Children were captivated by the stories of Jesus in words they understood. Teens asked to play Scripture while the team prepared and ate evening meals each day.

The day before the trip ended, our partner gave the Proclaimer to a Pokot community elder and spent an hour explaining how to use the Audio Bible to share God's Word with more listeners. As the medical team left the next day, they saw the elder carrying the Proclaimer and gathering a group to listen together.

The community received significant physical healing and exciting potential for spiritual healing through Scripture in their mother tongue.

E Americas

Gospel Films paint historically accurate and visually stunning pictures of first-century Jerusalem and Judea. By combining both visual and audible elements, Gospel Films provide a vivid way to connect to Scripture for many audiences. In the Dominican Republic, churches and individuals host watching groups for family, friends, and neighbors.

Manny suffered a stroke ten years ago. He recounted the sad aftereffects: "I was physically changed, and friends who once greeted me with affection turned their backs on me. The medical treatments promised through my job never came through. I felt rejected and helpless."

A decade's worth of hopelessness lifted when Manny accepted an invitation to a Gospel Film viewing in Santo Domingo. The message of Jesus' compassion and sacrifice comforted his loneliness, as did the interaction with other viewers. Later, Manny joined a Bible listening group and told our partners, "Old hurts caused me to distrust others, and I isolated myself through bad behavior. This Bible listening group teaches me to be empathetic and loving. My life has changed because I learned Jesus heals all kinds of wounds. He is the way, the truth, and the life."



Father, You are our comfort and shelter through any storm. We pray that as more people have the chance to interact with Your Word through film, they find rest in Your perfect ways.

Experiencing God's Covenant

A NEW BIBLICAL FILM RESOURCE

1,468 languages now have at least one Gospel Film; many have two or more. Gospel Films, excellent word-for-word productions, allow watching group participants to see the life of Christ play out visually, and for many, seeing is believing.

A woman in Bangladesh shares her testimony: "Because I was born into poverty, I could not afford to go to school. I live with my husband and our two children. Together we attend the community church. It was there we first saw the Gospel Film. Watching the story of Christ play on the projector changed me. It is one thing for people to tell you about Jesus. But being able to watch and listen on your own is truly a blessed gift."

The original films were produced by Bible Media Group (BMG) and adapted by Faith Comes By Hearing into various languages.

BMG's newest film, **The Covenant,** includes key Old Testament selections which help bridge the gap between God's promise to Abraham and the realization of God's promise through His Son. In communities familiar with the Abrahamic covenant, this film sets the stage before viewing the life of Christ in Gospel Films.

Beginning with the Matigsalug language of the Philippines, Faith Comes By Hearing and BMG have adapted The Covenant into 63 languages this fiscal year, with plans for 50 more languages in FY25. BMG has also committed to filming the Book of Acts, another key Scripture portion, for new church plants around the world.

Asia

Ten years ago, Faith Comes By Hearing recorded God's Word in the secure language of a tribal mountain community in rural Vietnam. Thanks to partners in Bible translation, faithful supporters, and God's miraculous provision, people living in spiritual darkness heard Scripture in their heart language.

Fast forward to the present—and thousands of Audio Bibles later. The human degradation plaguing this region has decreased. Through a recent radio broadcast, Bible listeners in one village grasped the life-changing teachings of Christ. Hearers became doers of the Word. The people prayed for deliverance from their vices. God heard. God healed. The community bears little resemblance to its former way of life.

Faith Comes By Hearing remains committed to record and freely provide Scripture in more Vietnamese languages. The nuanced work in this hard-to-reach country requires discretion. Through creative assembly and shipping methods, Audio Bibles safely reach trained program implementers.

Ongoing Audio Bible engagement makes an eternal difference. Prayer and partnership enables more people to know the power of Scripture in a language and format they can deeply comprehend.

Celebrating 2,000

ORAL BIBLE TRANSLATION LEADS THE WAY

On our God-given mission to record and freely provide His Word, Faith Comes By Hearing surpassed a noteworthy milestone: **the 2,000th language community to receive Scripture in audio.** We celebrate this achievement with gratitude for the hundreds of like-minded ministries and translation agencies who journey with us.

As we travel beyond 2,000 languages, we realize that oral cultures are the final frontier of people groups still waiting for God's Word in audio. Oral Bible Translation (OBT) leads the way to Truth in their heart language by empowering indigenous speakers. Bible translation experts guide mother tongue translators as they listen and internalize using a reference language. They then translate Scripture orally via Render, a software specifically designed for OBT. The dynamic outcome is immediate, meaningful access as portions are finalized.

Carried by decades of partnership, Faith Comes By Hearing's Scripture recordings have reached an incalculable number of listening ears. We think it fitting that the 2,000th language to receive God's audible Word is spoken by an oral tribe in Malaysia.

22,000 Murut Tahol speakers can now meaningfully engage with the Word of God in their heart language. Thanks to OBT, a tribe overcoming their head-hunting ancestors' reputation stepped out of their dark past and into the light of the Gospel.

Meeting The Need

RENDER 3 RELEASE



"Render 3's flexibility lets partners complete translations according to their specific needs. By easing the barriers of entry, more communities can translate and record Scripture in their heart languages." – OBT Field Trainer

Render, the software behind Oral Bible Translation, launched in 2017. Since then, more than 200 languages have received portions of Scripture. This explosive growth meant upgrades quickly became necessary. Render 2 (2018) introduced much-needed stability, setting the foundation for the work to come.

In the initial years of the program, OBT maintained a fixed, linear workflow, facilitated in Render. But as more communities used OBT, the need for an adaptable workspace grew. 2023 saw this updated in the long-anticipated launch of **Render 3**.

Eager to meet the challenge head on, our developers set to work creating a more intuitive workspace. With an adapted, simplified dashboard, teams can tailor the program to fit the needs of each unique recording. Render 3 created a flexible, more efficient workspace, with the potential to provide the community quicker access to approved Scripture portions. While in-house testing proved promising, the question remained: Would Render 3 succeed or crumble in the face of challenges?

Field tests in Mexico and Nigeria gave us the answer. The first test, a partner recording, allowed experienced Render 2 users to test the full flexibility of the updated interface. A larger group unfamiliar with the Render software underwent the second field test. This group's size made it possible to explore the full limits of the software on a large project.

With the success of the field tests, the global OBT community anticipated the launch of the new software. Render 3 is now in use for every new Faith Comes By Hearing OBT project started around the world. These advancements will provide an estimated 1,200 communities the means to hear God speak their language.

Eurasia / Middle East / North Africa

Raya loves afternoons in the city park. The new Christ follower takes her Audio Bible and plays Scripture in her language loud enough to catch the attention of passersby. Curiosity often attracts a gathering around her and the Proclaimer.

Taking the opportunity to share with anyone willing to listen, Raya described the changes in her mind, heart, and body that came when she heard and believed the Gospel:

"High blood pressure caused me to have terrible headaches, and medication offered little help. Stress mounted until I met a friend who gave me an Audio Bible and offered to pray for my healing. I needed this encouragement, so I listened and received the Gospel's comforting message."

"Peace I cannot explain flooded my mind as I heard about Christ's sacrifice for both physical and spiritual healing. I put my faith in Him, and in the days that followed, my symptoms disappeared. My blood pressure normalized, and now I no longer need medication."



Thank You, God, for the healing power of Your Word. May pure Audio Scripture reach the ears of all in this vast region and bring about life transformation.

Pacific / Oceania

God's Word is at work in the hearts of the Nasioi people on Bougainville Island, one of Papua New Guinea's most remote provinces. Desiring to reach their communities for Christ, more than 40 local leaders and pastors gathered for three days of Bible listening group training.

On the last day, everyone agreed that the best way to end the workshop would be to conduct a listening group of their own. Everyone listened and reflected as the Proclaimers played Scripture in their heart language of Nasioi. Afterward, the group appointed and prayed over six coordinators who would oversee the listening group efforts across the island.

The workshop concluded with the dedication and distribution of the Audio Bibles. Everyone returned to their communities, empowered and ready to share God's audible Word with others. Today, the six coordinators provide training and leadership to more than 100 listening groups in the area.


