



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Hdc = Half double
 crochet

PM = Place marker
Rep = Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch
St(s) = Stitch(es)

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

20 sc and 22 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Project is worked as a spiral. **Do not** join rnds. Move marker up each rnd to maintain rnd count.

Beg using magic ring method, demonstrated [here](#):

1st rnd: Ch 1. 8 sc in in ring. PM on last st of rnd. 8 sc.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 16 sc.

3rd rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 24 sc.

4th rnd: *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 32 sc.

5th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around. 40 sc.

6th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

7th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * around. 48 sc.

8th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Rep from * around. 56 sc.

9th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around. 64 sc.

10th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

11th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Rep from * around. 72 sc.

12th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Rep from * around. 80 sc.

13th and 14th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Softee Cotton™ (4.2 oz/120 g; 254 yds/232 m)

Fuchsia (69023)

1 ball or 190 yds/173 m

Size U.S. E/4 [3.5 mm] Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. Susan Bates® split ring stitch marker. 38" [96.5 cm] of plastic hat brim wire. Crimp bead.

15th rnd: *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Rep from * around. 88 sc.

16th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

17th rnd: *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. Rep from * around. 96 sc.

18th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

19th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc. Rep from * around. 104 sc.

20th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

21st rnd: *1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Rep from * around. 112 sc.

22nd to 34th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

35th rnd: *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc around.

36th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 13 sc. Rep from * around. 120 sc.

Note: Switch to hdc for next rnds.

37th rnd: *2 hdc in next sc. 1 hdc in each of next 9 sc. Rep from * around. 132 hdc.

38th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc. Rep from * around. 144 hdc.

39th rnd: *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 11 hdc. Rep from * around. 156 hdc.

40th rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. Rep from * around. 168 hdc.

41st rnd: *1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc each of next 9 hdc. Rep from * around. 180 hdc.

Add hat brim wire: Next rnd:

Holding plastic brim wire along top of 41st rnd and crocheting around, work 1 sc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Trim plastic brim wire and secure with crimp bead.
