MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/ 201 m)

Contrast A Pink Dust (10956) **1 ball or 125 yds/114.5 m**

Contrast B Misty Green (10878) 1 ball or 75 yds/68.5 m

Contrast C Sand (10014) **1 ball or 75 yds/68.5 m**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) Susan Bates® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. Sewing pins. ½" [1.25 cm] pair of safety eyes. Polyfil stuffing.

Rnd(s) = Round(s) Sc = Single crochet Sc2(3)tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2(3) sc. Yoh and draw through all loops on

MEASUREMENT

Approx 11" [28 cm] tall.

GAUGE

7 sc and 8 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

CAKE ICING

With A, ch 3.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in last ch. Turn. 2 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 4 sc.

3rd and 4th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

5th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. **6th to 26th rows:** Rep 3rd to 5th rows 7 times more. 20 sc.

hook

27th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

28th row: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

29th to 43rd rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

44th row: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

45th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.



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46th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 18 sc. **47th and 48th rows:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Rep 46th to 48th rows until 2 sts rem, ending on a 46th row. Fasten off.

Top Edge Frosting: 1st row: (RS). Join B with sl st to 1st rem front loop of 27th row. Working in front loops only, *Popcorn in next st. SI st in next st. Rep from * to last st. (Popcorn. SI st) in last st. Fasten off.

Bottom Edge Frosting: 1st row: (RS). Join B with sl st to 1st rem front loop of 43rd row. Ch 1. Working in front loops only, *1 sc in next sc. Ch 2. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Fasten off.

CAKE LAYERS Cake Layers Stripe Pat

With C, 4 rows.

With B, 2 rows.

With C, 4 rows.

With B, 2 rows.

With C, 4 rows.

These 16 rows complete Cake Layers Stripe Pat.

With C, ch 51.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 50 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Rep 2nd row until all 16 rows of Stripe Pat have been worked. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Attach safety eyes and embroider cheeks with A on Cake Layers as shown in photo.

Joining Cake Layers and Cake Icing: Referring to diagram, pin Cake Layers and Cake Icing tog to help with joining.

1st rnd: Working through both thicknesses, join A with sl st anywhere along meeting edges of Cake Layers and Cake Icing. Ch 2. Work hdc evenly around all edges. Stuff Cake firmly before completing joining edge. Join with sl st to first hdc. Fasten off.

Icing Dollop

With B. ch 11.

1st row: Sc2tog over 2nd and 3rd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to last ch. 2 sc in last ch. Turn. 10 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 2 sc in first sc.1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn.

4th to 12th rows: Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 4 times more, then 2nd row once.

Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail.

Sew ends tog to create tube. Gather top edge of tube. Pull tight and secure. Do not break. Using same yarn tail, gather bottom edge of tube. Pull tight and secure.

Sew Icing Dollop to top of Cake as shown in picture.
