### **Request**

Following the recent Branchage inspection in the Parish of St Peter on the 29th June 2017, I should be grateful if you could provide the number of parishioners, if any who received fines / prosecution under the Loi (1914) sur la Voirie / Loi (1995) (Amendement) sur la Voirie, on roads Rue De Sauvelleries and La Rue Du Saut Falluet, St Peter, which is in the Douet Vingtaine. In short, I am seeking information as to how many landowners, if any, received fines / prosecution on both these roads for failing to comply with the Branchage Law.

### **Response**

A fine / prosecution may be imposed on a person who does not remove the branchage, obstacle or other deleterious matter in accordance with the requirements of a written order issued by the Connétable.

A person who fails to cut the overhanging branches growing from their properties, and remove the cuttings, in the manner required under the Loi (1914) sur la Voirie is liable to an administrative penalty for each infringement. Two administrative penalties were imposed in June 2017 for failure to comply with the requirements on Rue De Sauvelleries and La Rue Du Saut Falluet, St Peter.
