I would like to request the following information via Freedom of Information:

For each parish please can you provide the tonnage of recycling collected from the kerbside for each of the following items?

- -glass
- -plastic
- -paper
- -cardboard
- -metal/tin

Please can you provide a monthly breakdown for each item for between October 2019 and the end of September 2020?

Response

St Brelade and St Peter - Information on recycling is published by Premier Waste Recycling – see <http://premierwaste.org.uk/recycling-data/>. No information is held on glass recycling or on the split between paper and cardboard.

St Clement – glass is collected weekly alongside household refuse but the figures regarding tonnage are not held. There is no other kerbside recycling collection but there are bring banks located in the Parish.

St Ouen - glass is collected monthly but the figures regarding tonnage are not held. There is no other kerbside recycling collection but there are bring banks located in the Parish.

Grouville and St Martin – glass collection figures are set out below. There is no other kerbside recycling collection but there are bring banks located in the Parish.
