Response

Under Article 16 of the FOI Law it states that where location, retrieval and extraction of data exceeds more than 5 hours, an FOI request can be refused as it exceeds the cost limit. Unfortunately the question will exceed the cost limit as it will require significant work to collate the information from paper records. However information on parish hall enquiries is returned to and collated by the States of Jersey Police.
