Request

In relation to each residents parking zone please let me have the following:

1. The number of spaces allocated to residents parking 24 hours a day
2. The number of spaces allocated to residents for periods of less than 24 hours a day
3. The number of parking permits issued in relation to the above
4. The number of people on the waiting list for the above
5. How many spaces are there in each zone for visitor parking (spaces that are available 24 hours per day)
6. How many spaces are there in each zone for visitor parking that are not available to visitors 24 hours per day (appreciate that some parking is 1 hour so assume 24 different visitors during that day for that one space)
7. How many business permits were issued in a month (say) June 2019.

Response

1. The number of spaces allocated to residents parking 24 hours a day

St Marks – 117
Richmond – 18
Cheapside – 87
St Thomas - 214
Total - 436

2. The number of spaces allocated to residents for periods of less than 24 hours a day

There are no specific 'less than 24hr' spaces allocated to residents only.
However, permit holders can park in other designated spaces (e.g. paycard spaces) outside of restricted hours for less than 24 hours, along with other drivers.

3. The number of parking permits issued in relation to the above –

The number of resident permits issued in respect of spaces described in questions 1 are:

St Marks - 150

Richmond - 16
Cheapside - 118
St Thomas – 281
Total - 565

4. The number of people on the waiting list for the above

The number of residents on the waiting list in respect of spaces described in questions 1 are:

St Marks - 52
Richmond - 0
Cheapside - 24
St Thomas – 106
Total – 182

5. How many spaces are there in each zone for visitor parking (spaces that are available 24 hours per day)

None. Visitors can park in designated pay card spaces between the hours of 09:00 – 22:00 only.

6. How many spaces are there in each zone for visitor parking that are not available to visitors 24 hours per day (appreciate that some parking is 1 hour so assume 24 different visitors during that day for that one space)

The number of designated visitor spaces are:

St Marks – 35
Richmond – 8
Cheapside – 33
St Thomas – 74
Total - 150

7. How many business permits were issued in a month (say) June 2019.

No new business permits were issued in June 2019; two duplicate business permits were issued.

Eighteen Temporary Permits were issued to businesses and tradesmen to carry out work on a property in a zone during June 2019. Individual zone information is unavailable.
