St Helier received an extra £640,000 in 2018:

- 1 How much of this money has been spent so far?
- 2 How much has been earmarked for specific projects?
- What are these projects?

Response

- 1 No monies have been expended on any projects to date.
- 2 & 3 A Parish Assembly held on 31 January 2018 supported the expenditure of the funds received in lieu of rates from the States on the following projects, with the estimates provided being maximum amounts; any unspent funds will return to the Parish's General Reserve -
 - Up to £155,000 for a feasibility study for the Havre des Pas Village Improvement scheme
 - Up to a maximum of £250,000 for the refurbishment of Halkett Street
 - Up to a maximum of £150,000 for pedestrian safety improvements in Tower Road
 - Up to a maximum of £87,000 for extra places in the Parish's apprenticeship scheme.
