Extract of Roads Committee Minute 17 October 2001

The Connétable reported that, in response to approaches from the Headteacher of the JCG and the States of Jersey Police Road Safety Officer, he would be attending a site meeting in company with the Connétable of St Helier to discuss traffic and child safety issues along Claremont Road.

Extract of Roads Committee Minute 18 August 2008

School Crossing/Claremont Road

The Committee met on site to discuss concerns raised by parents regarding the road crossing from the car park at JCG and the Preparatory School opposite.

Despite the existence of roads signs on both approaches to the crossing, the Committee agreed to heighten awareness by painting two "SLOW" signs on the approaches in high visibility white paint with red background.

Extract of Roads Committee Minute 18 October 2012

Rue de Patier

Clos de Patier Residents Association has again written requesting that the Roads Committee reconsider the problems of speed along Rue de Patier and the parking of vehicles opposite the entrance of Clos de Patier.

Residents of the Clos and also claim that vehicles continue to travel at speed along the road and the danger to road users is exacerbated by the narrowing of the road outside Clos de Patier caused by inconsiderate and sometimes long term parking.

Following the previous meeting of the Roads Committee, residents of Clos de Patier had been requested to cut back plants and shrubs overhanging the road and obstructing vision. The Parish Foreman

has also placed an order for a prohibition line to be painted opposite and within a 10 yard radius of the entrance/exit.

In addition to the above the Committee agreed to review the speed by asking the Honorary Police to erect "SIDS" to monitor traffic and seek the advice of Transport & Technical Services with regard to reducing the speed limit to 20mph.

It was suggested that a 20mph limit also be considered for Chasse Brunet and Sunshine/Little Sunshine Avenue.

Extract of correspondence to Minister for TTS 22 November 2012

I am directed by the Constable, on behalf of the Roads Committee, to write requesting amendments to the Road Traffic legislation as detailed below.

Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (Jersey) Order 2003

20mph speed restriction as per Schedule 2.

1. **La Rue du Patier** - from the junction with Bagatelle Road to the junction with St. Saviour's Hill.
2. **Chasse Brunet** – from the junction with St. Saviour's Hill to the junction with Bagatelle Road.

Note: the 20mph speed limits were imposed by the Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (Amendment No. 9) (Jersey) Order 2015 which came into force on 2 March 2015.
