How many residential on street parking places are there in St Helier? Is there a Parish strategy for providing charging facilities for the on street parking? Is there any correspondence from the Parish liaising with the appropriate States Department regarding providing charging facilities for the on street parking?

Response

1. *How many residential on street parking places are there in St Helier?*

St Marks Residents Parking Zone - 112 spaces

Richmond Road Residents Parking Zone – 19 spaces

St Thomas Residents Parking Zone - 213 spaces

Cheapside Residents Parking Zone – 88 spaces

Total number spaces in Residents Parking Zones - 432

2. *Is there a Parish strategy for providing charging facilities for the on-street parking?*

There is no strategy in place, although the Constable is currently leading a review of parking at which electric charging-points are a point of discussion. As the Parish develops Neighbourhood Improvement Areas (NIA's) it will consider an electric charging option. Resident Parking Zone (RPZ) users have not supported the introduction of on street charging in RPZ zones. 3. *Is there any correspondence from the Parish liaising with the appropriate States Department regarding providing charging facilities for the on-street parking?*

The only correspondence the Parish has had with the Government of Jersey Infrastructure Department, is to make necessary changes to the Road Traffic (St Helier) (Jersey) Order 1996 to enable on-street electric charging to be undertaken on Parade Road. The existing electric charge points were available following the spaces being relinquished by Evie. The legislation has since been amended (see the Road Traffic (Miscellaneous Amendments – Electric Vehicle Parking) (Jersey) Order 2023 R&O.106/2023 available on [jerseylaw.je](https://www.jerseylaw.je)) and the Parish is implementing the charges.
