2. Approval of Minutes	The minutes of the meeting held on 11 January 2024 were proposed by DBC and seconded by SP and duly adopted.	
3. Matters Arising		
3.1. La Grande Route des Sablons	In relation to ML approving parking for contractors at La Rocque during the resurfacing of La Grande Route des Sablons in the summer, DBC advised against as complaints may be received for blocking beach access and suggested contacting Master Farms for alternative parking arrangements. The committee agreed.	
	ACTION POINT: ML to contact [redacted] from WSP.	
3.2. [redacted]	ML advised that [redacted] will provide information regarding Old Road once he has looked at Trusts.	
	DBC referred to a development by La Rocque, which is in front of a pavement and suggested that [redacted] is approached regarding the measurement of the pavement, as it must be reinstated as Infrastructure and Environment will have it measured once the development is finished.	
	ACTION POINT: ML to contact [redacted] regarding the above.	
3.3. Infrastructure and Environment	EG commented that the new Minister of Infrastructure and Environment should be invited to a Roads Committee (RC) meeting. This follows prior dialogue with the Minister on the junction at Fauvic Crossroads, which was the site of a double fatal RTA in 2023.	
	ACTION POINT: ML to arrange a meeting with the new Minister of Infrastructure.

4. Planning Applications	ML advised that his name has been put forward to join the Planning Committee and if his application is approved, ML will be unable to participate in discussions regarding planning applications with the RC.

	DBC left the meeting during discussion of planning application RP/2023/1458. The Committee discussed the application and had no objections.
	The RC reported the following concerns:
	- How parking is affected in planning application P/2023/1413
	- The location and height of the installed fence for planning application P/2023/1368
	No further concerns were reported.
	ACTION POINT: PDS to request further information regarding applications 1413 and 1368.
5. Journal Entries	DC highlighted that the around £10k of the sum of £10,472.25 under 'road repairs' was a payment to DB Cummins Ltd for repairs at La Cache des Pres.
	ML advised that dog licence income will be removed from the roads budget into the general account.
	No concerns were reported on the journal entry.
6. Branchage	The following Branchage dates were agreed by the RC:
	- 1 st Branchage 05 July 2024
	- 2 nd Branchage 13 September 2024
	EG suggested notifying parishioners of the agreed dates in the Grouville Gazette.
	The meeting discussed venues for the Branchage meal and the RC agreed to book The Pembroke for 13 September 2024.
	DBC suggested that Holme Grown be invited to submit a price for the July Branchage. The Committee agreed.
	ACTION POINT: DC to book The Pembroke.
7. Les Fonds de Longueville	ML provided an update regarding the road closure at Les Fonds de Longueville and advised that further work is being undertaken to make the area safe. After further discussion, the RC agreed to keep Les Fonds de Longueville closed and to thank the [redacted] for providing updates to the Parish.

8. AOB.	
8.1. Dog Licences	ML asked for a proposition to remove dog licences from the roads budget to the general budget. DC advised that dog licences must be removed from the roads budget by law, which should have been done in 2016. ML understood.
8.2. Trees	DBC advised that the road works at La Cache des Pres can't be finished until the tree roots have been taken back.
	ACTION POINT: ML to contact the National Trust about the tree roots.
	DBC mentioned that the tree at La Rue du Moulin is still blocking the road.
	ACTION POINT: ML to contact Jersey Royal regarding the blocked road.
	DBC commented on the tree root that damaged La Ruette Mauthrin which was recently resurfaced and after further discussion, DBC advised he will obtain a quote, from the contractors who originally resurfaced the road, to resurface the road again before ML contacts the owner of the tree.
	ACTION POINT: DBC to provide a quote to resurface La Ruette Mauthrin.
8.3. Signage	EG advised that new signs are required on both ends of Le Boulivot de Haut.
	ACTION POINT: EG to provide photographs of the signs to DC
	ACTION POINT: DC to order new signs.
	ML mentioned that Beach Road requires a road name sign. DBC reminded that the Parish has up to five road name signs to make due to the size of the sheet that is used to make the signs. After further discussion, the RC agreed to wait until the Road Inspectors have submitted their annual reports. PDS confirmed that the Roads Inspectors have been given a deadline of Friday, 29 March 2024 to submit their reports.

Part 1 - Fauvic Crossroads

ML thanked Andy Jehan and Mark Richardson for taking the time to meet with the Roads Committee (RC) at Fauvic Crossroads following the fatal road traffic accident in 2023.

DBC stressed that safety measures must be put in place to avoid any further accidents and commented that reducing the speed limit would not resolve matters.

EG presented photographs of painted rumble strips located on La Grande Route de Mont a L'abbe in the Parish of St. Helier, which help to reduce speeding in the area. DBC agreed with the idea.

Andy Jehan advised that suggestions have been made to make La Route des Cotils one way. DBC warned that doing so would encourage speeding and advised against a one-way system. The RC agreed. Andy Jehan then mentioned that the middle white lines on the road will be removed as this would encourage drivers to be more careful on the road.

After further discussion, the RC agreed to proceed with painted rumble strips on every access road at Fauvic Crossroads.

3.3. La Grande Route des Sablons	DBC advised that contractors may be able to park in the field next to Seymour Pub during the resurfacing of La Grande Route des Sablons.
	ML mentioned that [redacted] from WSP has been advised to contact Master Farms for parking arrangements.

5. Journal Entries	SP queried who has been assisting the Parish with the removal of trees during the recent storms. ML advised that it is one of the Parish's Connetable's Officers. DBC recommended that the Parish files a copy of their insurance to remove trees. The RC agreed.
	ACTION POINT: ML to obtain copy of the above insurance.
	DBC suggested that a separate item is included in the roads budget for all storm clearance expenses. The RC agreed.
	ACTION POINT: PDS to query DBC's suggestion with DC.
	No concerns were reported on the journal entry.
	DBC requested an update on Parish Rates. ML confirmed that there are a few outstanding payments.
6. La Rue de la Sente Maillard	The RC discussed a complaint from a parishioner regarding a yellow line that was not reinstated following roadworks that were undertaken at the end of La Rue de la Sente Maillard. The parishioner also requested that the road is swept due to the current state.
	After some discussion, ML said he will visit La Rue de la Sente Maillard this afternoon. ML acknowledged that the road requires sweeping, however the RC agreed that there is far too much water on the road at the moment.
	ACTION POINT: ML to visit La Rue de la Sente Maillard.

7.2. Beach Road	ML advised that a request has been made to place a road sign at the top of Beach Road and to put traffic calming measures in place. The RC agreed that traffic calming measures are not necessary in the area.
	DBC suggested that the RC schedule routes around the Parish twice a year, as done previously, to check if any work is required on roads, signs, etc. The RC agreed.
7.3. Road Name Signs	DBC advised that there are a few roads without road name signs and advised he had provided a list. PDS said she will print off the list to give the RC after the meeting.
7.4. Parking	ML mentioned that he has requested to the Minister for Infrastructure that an additional disabled parking space is placed outside the Parish Church, as it was previously agreed that two spaces would be made available, however only one space was created.
7.5. Les Fonds de Longueville	ML advised that Les Fonds de Longueville remains closed for now.
7.6. [redacted] - WSP	SP advised that the signs by the speed bumps on La Rue du Parcq and La Rue des Fonds have not been removed.
	EG mentioned that the white line to be painted by the bus stop at Fauvic Crossroads has not been done as agreed.

The Roads Committee (RC) received a presentation from the Sites Curator of Jersey Heritage regarding 20 small memorial stones of islanders who were imprisoned, persecuted or deported during the German Occupation. Only one of the 20 stones falls within the Parish of Grouville and the Sites Curator advised that they wish to have this placed on La Rue Maraval on 25 July 2024. The stone will lay flat along the road.

After further discussion the RC agreed that they had no objections to the proposed project.

ML advised he will provide the Sites Curator with contact details for Grouville School's Headteacher in case students would like to be involved.
