Request

Parishioners can ask for Reviews of the Assessment of Rate Quarters under Article 9 of the Rates Jersey Law
How many such requests for Review of Domestic Assessment were there in each Parish for 2024?

Response

An application for a Review of a rateable value must meet the criteria set out in Article 9(3) of the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005, which provides that an application may only be made on the grounds that there is a significant difference between the rateable value of the land in question and the rateable value of other land in Jersey having similar attributes to the land in question.

FOI exemption applied:

Article 25(2) - Personal Information - Personal data, applicant not subject but supply contravenes data protection principles

Information is absolutely exempt information if – (a) it constitutes personal data of which the applicant is not the data subject as defined in the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018; and (b) its supply to a member of the public would contravene any of the data protection principles, as defined in that Law.
