Request

In the minutes of the Parish of Grouville Roads Committee meeting on Thursday May 2nd 2024, the constable, Mark Labey, wished it to be minuted that "Green lanes are difficult to Police". I assume this is in regards to speeding. Please could you provide the policies and procedures for all the parishes in Jersey with regard to policing speed limits in green lanes. The purpose in asking this is to establish if the shining lights of best practice that can be shared and also to establish the level of concordance or dissonance with the different practices around the island.

Response

A 'Green Lane' is a road on which the speed limit is 15 m.p.h.

St Saviour and Trinity - no roads have a speed limit restricted to 15 m.p.h.

The other Parishes do not have policies and procedures relating to 'green lanes'; roads, including green lanes, are policed as and when required. Further information is exempt under Article 42 – Law Enforcement.

FOI exemption applied:

Article 42 - Law enforcement

Information is qualified exempt information if its disclosure would, or would be likely to, prejudice -

- (a) the prevention, detection or investigation of crime, whether in Jersey or elsewhere;
- (b) the apprehension or prosecution of offenders, whether in respect of offences committed in Jersey or elsewhere;
- (c) the administration of justice, whether in Jersey or elsewhere;
