Excellency,


I wish to refer to General Assembly Resolution 71/323 of 8 September 2017, by which the General Assembly decided to establish, at its seventy-second session, an Ad Hoc Working Group on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly, open to all Member States.

I have the honour to inform you that I have appointed H.E. Mr. Vladimir Drobnyak, Permanent Representative of Croatia, and H.E. Ms. María Emma Mejía Vélez, Permanent Representative of Colombia, as Co-Chairs of the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Revitalization of the Work of the General Assembly during the seventy-second session. I look forward to engaging with them and with all Member States on the many critical issues that the Working Group will consider this session.

I would like to thank Ambassadors Drobnyak and Mejía for having accepted this very important responsibility and I trust you will extend your full support and cooperation to them. I am confident that the forthcoming negotiations will build on the successful outcomes of the previous sessions of the Ad Hoc Working Group.
