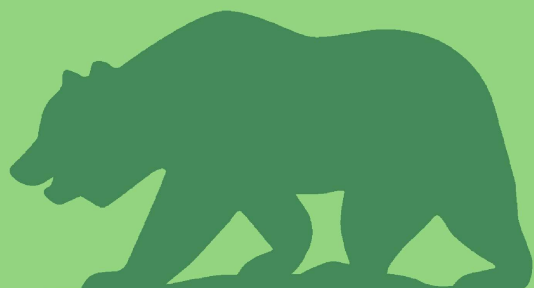

**ABOUT THIS STATEMENT OF VOTE
SEPTEMBER 14, 2021, CALIFORNIA GUBERNATORIAL RECALL ELECTION**

The Statement of Vote reports the county-by-county votes cast for the Recall Question¹ and for each Recall Election Gubernatorial Replacement Candidate. In a statewide contest such as the Recall Question and Recall Election Gubernatorial Replacement Candidates, the vote is reported by all 58 counties and listed in alphabetical order with the statewide total at the bottom. County specific data by precinct may be obtained by contacting the county directly.
