

Foundations, Artsy's Online Art Fair, Focused on Small & Emerging Galleries, Returns for its Third Edition

Fair dates: July 23–August 12, 2024 Preview July 22 on request



- The third edition of Foundations will see 71 small and emerging galleries—including 38 returning names—from across 6 continents.
- Foundations Summer 2024 will focus on artist-forward curation with emphasis put on smaller galleries that nurture early-career artists and artwork prices ranging from \$500-\$10,000.
- The Artsy Foundations Prize will also return to recognize an emerging artist for their promising talent, seen through their work exhibited in the fair.

The world's largest online art marketplace, Artsy announces the third edition of **Foundations**, a digital art fair that spotlights works from tastemaking galleries known for supporting emerging artists.

Foundations Summer 2024 features 71 exhibitors spanning 32 cities and continues Artsy's efforts to spotlight small and rising galleries. The **Summer 2024** edition will run from **July 23 to August 12** and will present works by fresh and lesser-known artists from across the globe.

"The previous success of Artsy's carefully curated Foundations online art fairs have been prime examples of how we champion smaller galleries and their talented artists. With

A wide range of first-time exhibitors include **Taymour Grahne Projects**, **Office Baroque**, **Secci**, **smoke the moon**, **PM/AM**, and **Johansson Projects**, **Alzueta Gallery**, **WHATIFTHEWORLD**, **Ross-Sutton Gallery**, and **Cob**.

Artsy is also delighted to announce the return of the **Artsy Foundations Prize**, which was inaugurated earlier this year during the Winter edition of the fair and recognizes an emerging artist for their promising talent, seen in their work presented during Foundations. The winner will receive a billboard spotlight in New York's landmark Times Square for two weeks, August 12–25th, giving the broader public an opportunity to discover their talent. A jury will determine the winning artist as well as four honorable mentions, based on a combination of factors, including overall originality and a fresh take on medium and subject matter, alongside signals of collector interest on the Artsy platform.

Foundations Summer 2024 reflects Artsy's greater emphasis and commitment to help people discover exceptional artworks and artists online.
