Philip Grech joined the Chair of Negotiation and Conflict Management at ETH Zurich in August 2015 as a postdoc and became a senior researcher in January 2018. Starting 2021 he will join the Public Policy Group at ETH Zurich to become the Executive Director of the Zurich branch of the Immigration Policy Lab. He studied Theoretical and Mathematical Physics at ETH Zurich and graduated as Dipl. Phys. ETH in 2008 and as Dr. sc. ETH Zurich in 2011. He also obtained a teaching degree for Swiss high schools (Didaktischer Ausweis) in 2010. After his studies, Philip worked as a joint PostDoc at the Department of Mathematics at McGill University and the Centre de Recherches Mathématiques in Montreal, Canada, followed by a position at a Swiss consulting firm. His current interests include mathematical modeling in general, distribution questions (e.g. in migration), (behavioral) game theory, negotiation analysis, voting theory and conflict resolution.
