Please follow these safety guidelines when visiting the Heal the Bay Aquarium:

- 1. While masks are no longer mandatory, they are a protective barrier that can help reduce the spread of respiratory infections. We recommend that our visitors and staff continue to wear them as a preventative measure.
- 2. Guests will not attend if they are sick with a fever and/or respiratory symptoms.
- 3. Guests will also not attend if they have come into contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- 4. No food or drink is allowed.
- 5. Hand sanitizer is available at our exit, and we have restrooms on site for guest convenience and use.
- 6. Stay up to date on the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 7.Get the flu shot to prevent influenza if you have not done so this season.
