



FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

From Wednesday September 12th through Thursday September 13th, The Hoffman Research Group surveyed a cross section of Oregon voters to ascertain their preferences in the 2018 Oregon Gubernatorial Election and their position on Oregon's Measure 105 which would repeal Oregon's Sanctuary State Law.

The survey is based on landline and cellphone interviews with 680 randomly chosen likely Oregon voters. Attention was given to Oregon's rural and urban divide within seven geographic regions. The survey also maintained appropriate balances with regard to age, gender and vote propensity.

The survey has a margin of error of plus or minus 3.8% at a 95% confidence level. Headquartered in Portland, OR, The Hoffman Research Group, a division of Gateway Communications Inc., has conducted hundreds of political tracking surveys and market research projects since 1984.

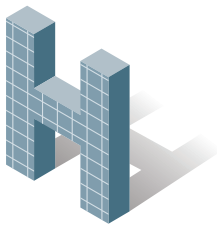
