Legislative Bills Supported By The Movement

LB 837 | Introduced by Senator Arch

Movement Position: Support

Mandates DHHS to implement a program to assist residential child care providers with costs of fingerprinting and national criminal record check.

LB 849 | Introduced by Pansing Brooks

Movement Position: Support

Defines intent and eligibility for Young Adult Bridge to Independence Program and extends eligibility to native youth aging out of Tribal Court proceedings.

LB 865 | Introduced by Senator Wayne

Movement Position: Support

Ensures employers contributing to employees' 529 account are not charged state income tax, employees maintain state aid benefits, and any state income tax refund is rolled into a 529 account.

LB 933 | Introduced by Crawford

Movement Position: Support

Extends utility disconnection grace period to 60 days, specifies customers have five business days to provide a medical note to postpone disconnection, and requires non-municipal utility companies to publish information about disconnections publicly.

LB 955 | Introduced by Senator Walz

Movement Position: Support

Requires DHHS to provide rationale when eligibility for services are discontinued or modified and allows recipient 30 days to appeal.

LB 997 | Introduced by Morfeld

Movement Position: Support

Adopts the Out-of-Network Emergency Medical Care Act to prevent "surprise billing" in emergency situations by out-of-network providers or facilities.

LB 1076 | Introduced by Bolz

Movement Position: Support

Expands the Community College Gap Assistance Program to include eligible programs at Nebraska's four tribal colleges.

LB 1107 | Introduced by Scheer

Movement Position: Oppose

Creates ImagiNE Nebraska Act to replace Nebraska Advantage Act and continues business tax incentives.
