

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Embassy of Sweden in Ukraine, To the management of NGO «Public television»

Opinion

Under the Contract № 11-2023-A dated 11.04.2023 we, the independent audit firm LLC "Audit company "UHY PROSTIR LTD" (included to the Register of auditors and audit entities under № 3388), have audited the accompanying Financial Statements of Non-Governmental Organization «Public television» (the Organization), comprising the Balance Sheet as at December 31, 2022, the Profit and Loss Statement for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements (the financial statements).

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements of the Organization for the year that ended on 31 December 2022 are prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with Ukrainian National Accounting Standards.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (ISAs). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements* section of our report. We are independent of the Organization in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements in Ukraine, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Emphasis of Matter - Influence of Russian Federation's Military Aggression against Ukraine

We draw your attention to the Note 4 «Going concern of the Organization», which describes the possible effect of full-scale invasion of the Russian Federation against Ukraine on the Organization's operational and financial performance, depending on future developments, including the duration, spread and intensity of the hostilities. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Other Matters - Implementation of Recommendations of Previous Auditors

We audited the Organization's financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2021 and expressed an unmodified opinion on those financial statements on 08 June 2022. The Organization was recommended to include expenses, directly incurred in commercial projects and for which incomes from services are accrued, to the line 2050 "Cost of sales" of the Profit and Loss Statement. The Organization implemented the recommendation and in 2022 reflected costs related to commercial projects in the respective line of Profit and Loss Statement.

Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation of the financial statements in accordance with the Ukrainian National Accounting Standards and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the Organization's ability



to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters relating to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Organization or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for supervision over the Organization's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with ISAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with ISAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.

We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to
 fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit
 evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not
 detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error,
 as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override
 of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures
 that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the
 effectiveness of the Organization's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by management.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of management's use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the Organization's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Organization to cease to continue as a going concern.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

Notes to the financial statements of Non-Governmental Organization "Public television" for year ended on December, 31st, 2022

1.General information

Non-Governmental Organization "Public television" (hereinafter – the Organization) is a voluntary association of individuals established for implementation of protection of rights and freedoms, satisfaction of public, in particular, social, cultural, informational, creative and other non-commercial interests.

The main directions of Organization's activity are: collection, processing, creation, storing and preparation of information, issuing and distributing news, providing photo-, video- and other informational products to mass media, state governing authorities and other legal entities and individuals.

2. Basis of preparation and presentation

Financial statements consist of:

- Financial report of the small enterprise subject including Balance sheet (form № 1-m) as at 31.12.2022 and Profit and Loss statement (form № 2-m) for year ended on December, 31st, 2022, prepared in accordance with the rules of the National accounting standards in Ukraine, namely NAS 25 "Simplified financial report". Financial report of the small enterprise subject is prepared in accordance with the accrual's principle and valuation at initial cost method:
- Notes to the financial statements.

Financial statements are presented in hryvnias, and all the amounts are rounded to thousands with one decimal point.

Financial statements were approved for issue on 17 May 2023.

3. Disclosure of information on separate items of financial statements

3.1. Intangible assets

Line 1000 «Intangible assets» of the Balance Sheet includes remaining value of computer programs, internet site, certificate for a logo for goods and services, broadcasting license, copyrights for television programs etc.

Depreciation of the intangible assets is accrued using the straight-line method. Useful life term is defined at the moment of recognition and is analyzed at the end of every year reporting period and is adjusted if necessary.

Part of intangible assets has indefinite useful life term. Depreciation is not accrued for such items. Balance sheet value of such intangible assets as at 31.12.2022 amounts to 3 413,1 thousand UAH (as at 31.12.2021 – 2 909,8 thousand UAH).

3.2. Fixed assets

Line 1010 «Fixed assets» of the Balance Sheet includes remaining value of computer, video-, office equipment, furniture, instruments, other non-current assets, initial value of which exceeds 20 000,00 UAH.

Fixed assets received on the account of using donors' funds are reflected in the purchase amount minus accumulated depreciation as at the reporting date.

Depreciation of the fixed assets (except the other non-current assets) is accrued using the straight-line method. Useful life term is defined at the moment of recognition and is analyzed at the end of every year reporting period and is adjusted if necessary.

Expenditures for repair works and technical maintenance of fixed assets are reflected in the Profit and Loss statement during the financial period in which they were incurred.

4. Going concern of the Organization

These financial statements are based on the going concern principle of the Organization, which provides for the realization of assets and fulfillment of obligations in the normal course of the Organization's activities. However, there are the following events and circumstances that required the management's careful assessment of the Organization 's ability to continue operations on a going concern basis and took measures to ensure that the Organization had adequate funding. These events and circumstances are detailed below.

Notes to the financial statements of Non-Governmental Organization "Public television" for year ended on December, 31st, 2022

On February 24, 2022 the Russian Federation carried out a full-scale invasion of Ukraine. On the same day, in connection with the military aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine (hereinafter - military aggression) by Decree of the President of Ukraine № 64/2022 on our territory martial law was imposed from 05 hours 30 minutes on February 24, 2022, which is valid repeatedly continued and which is currently in force.

At the date of approval of this financial statement the Organization operates in an unstable economic environment caused by Russian military aggression. Improvement of the economic situation in the country depends on future developments, including the duration, spread and intensity of the warfare, all of which are uncertain and difficult to predict considering the rapidly evolving situation. Due to the uncertainty of the timing and directions of the intense hostilities it is not possible to reliably estimate the impact of it on the financial results and liquidity of the Organization, the stability and structure of its operations with counterparties.

These financial statements have been prepared on a going concern assumption of the Organization, which provides for the realization of assets and settlement of liabilities in the normal course of its activities. The financial statements do not include any adjustments to reflect the possible future effects of compensation and classification of reported assets or the amounts and classification of liabilities that may arise from such uncertainty.
