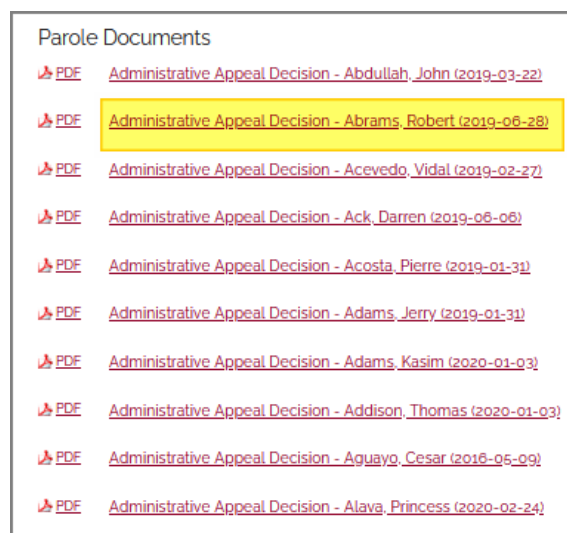
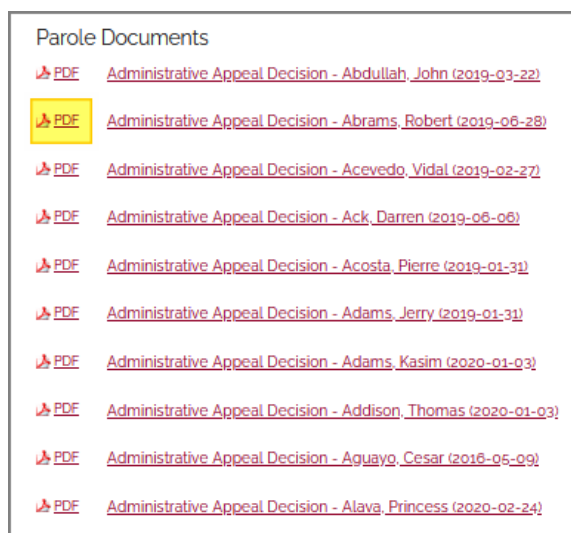
Browsing the Collection

On the project homepage, click on a category




To access full text of a document from the browse screen, click the **PDF icon**



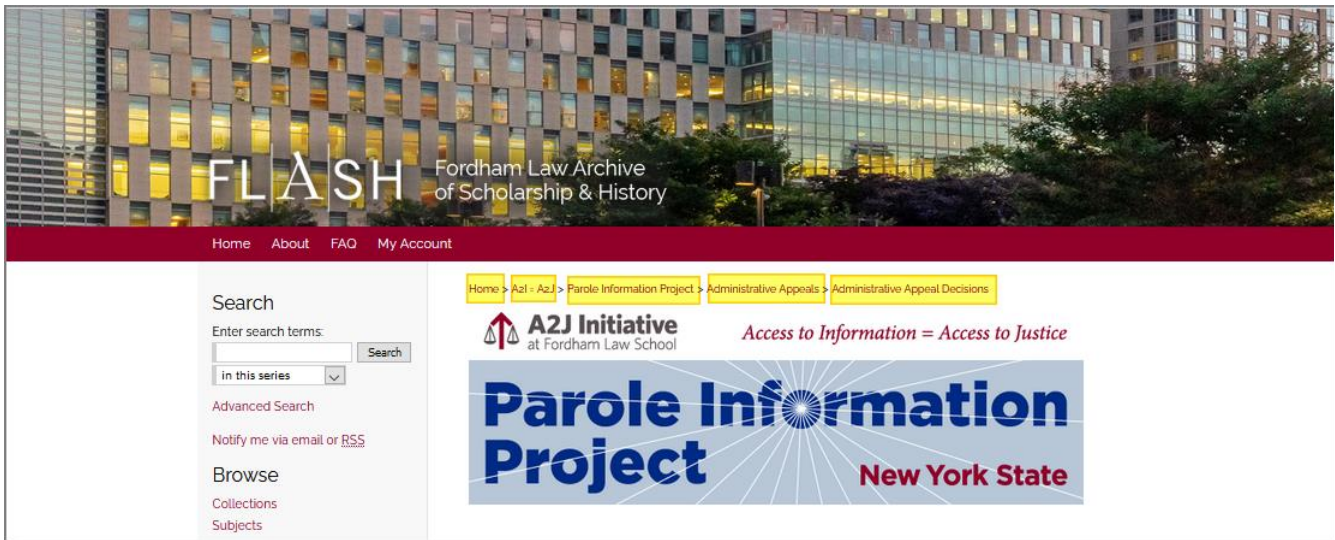

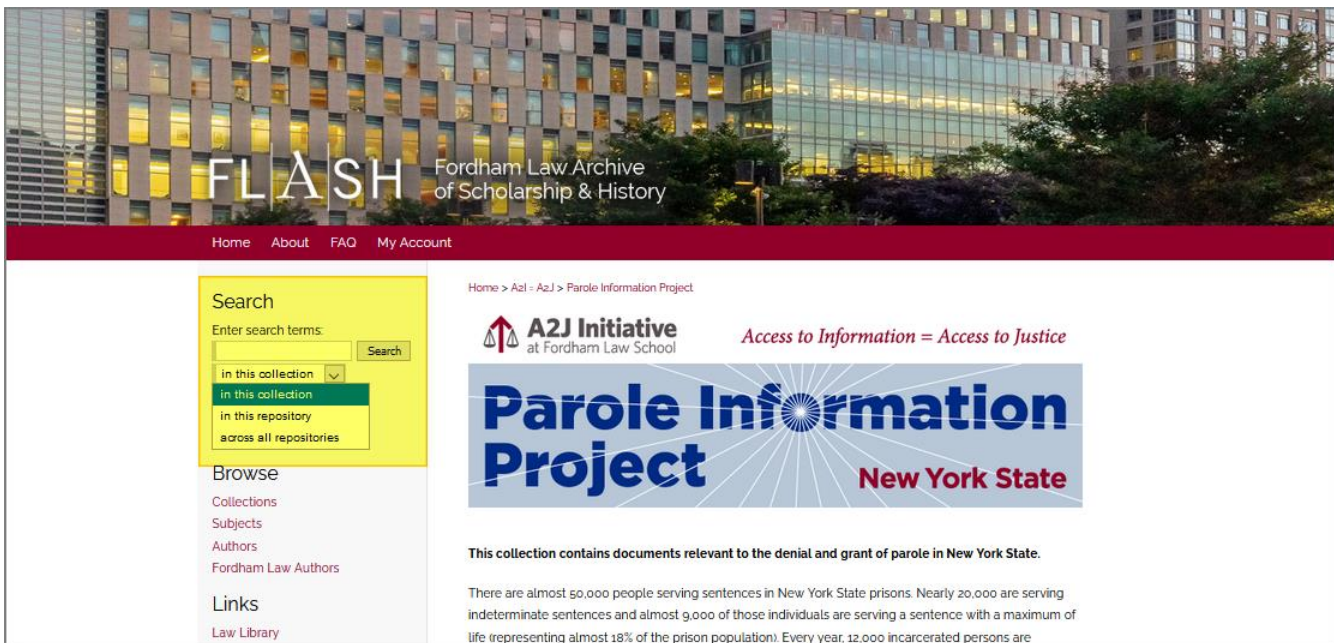

Searching the Collection

Searching from a collection page: Enter your search term in the search box. From the drop-down menu below, select the scope of your search: this collection; this repository [FLASH]; or across all [Digital Commons] repositories. Click **Search**.

Boolean operators **AND**, **OR**, **NOT** (in upper case) are supported.



Note that when searching from one of the project's sub-collections (e.g., Administrative Appeal Decisions), the first scope option will change from "collection" to "series". This means that your search will be limited to that sub-collection/series.
