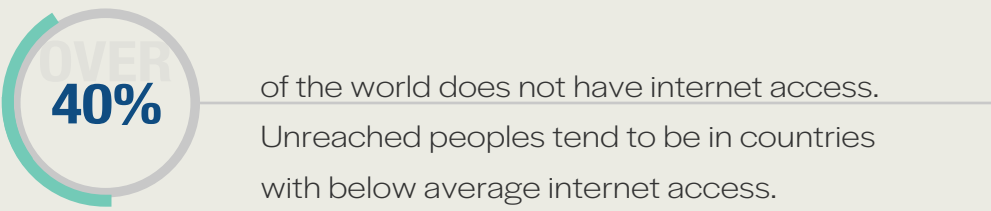
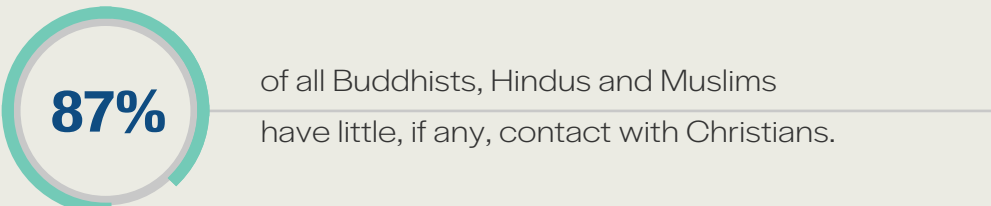
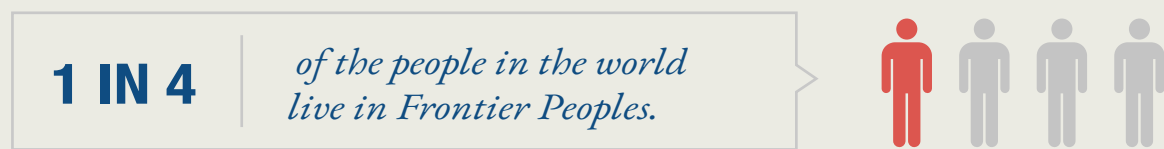


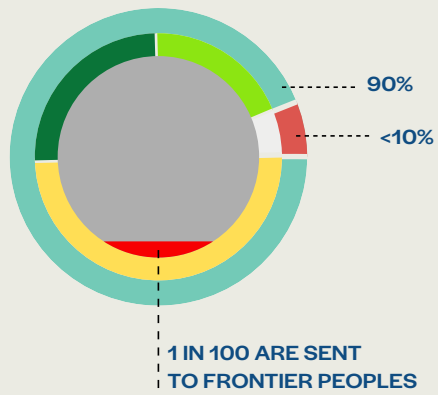
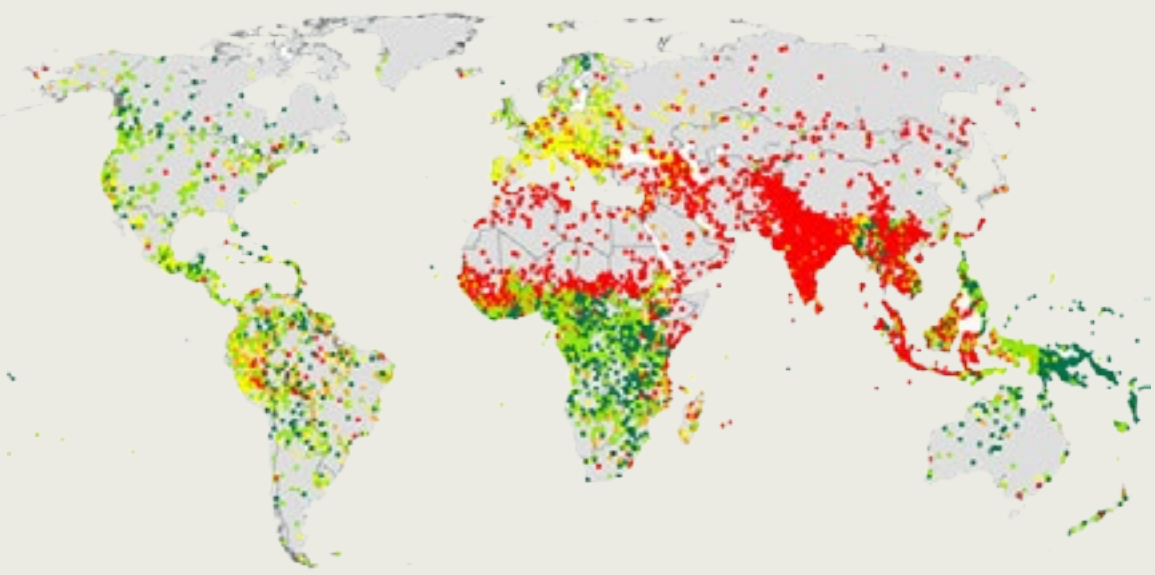
WHY STILL UNREACHED?

LIMITED ACCESS

There are about 4,975 Frontier Unreached People Groups where less than 1 in 1,000 identify with Jesus in any way.



LIMITED WORKERS



Over 90% of long-term missionaries work in already Christianized groups (yellow and green dots). Less than 10% — some researchers suggest less than 3% — of all missionaries work in unreached people groups (red dots). Even more dire among Frontier Unreached Peoples as most mission agencies and churches send less than 1 in 100 (1%) of their missionaries to Frontier Peoples.

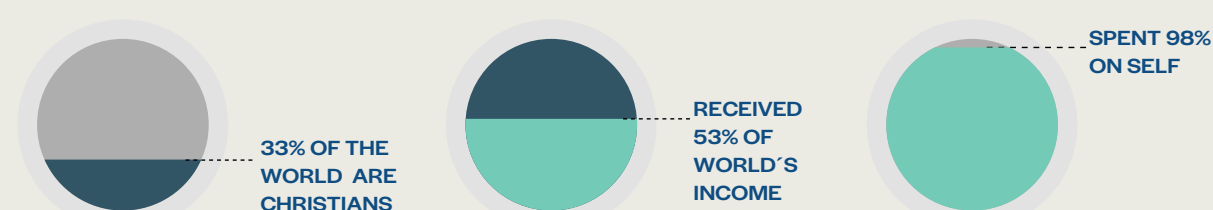
95% of pastors lack formal theological training.

LIMITED VISION

76% of U.S. churchgoers either have not heard of the “Great Commission” or do not know what it means.

THE GREAT COMMISSION

Acts 1:8 is viewed as sequential ... “Jerusalem then Judea then Samaria then the ends of the earth” instead of “Jerusalem and Judea and Samaria and the ends of the earth” ... we don’t get to the ends of the earth because of legitimate local needs.



Christians adherents make up 33% of the world’s population and received 53% of the world’s annual income and spend 98% of it on ourselves.

LIMITED CHURCHES

No indigenous churches to partner with. The table below compares the number of churches in cities of approximately the same size in the US and in unreached areas.

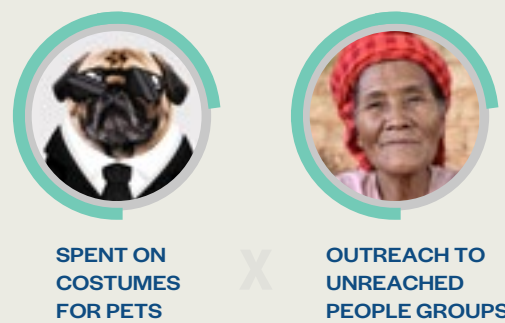

There are more Christ-followers in the average Sunday School class in the US than Christ-followers in the 27.4 million who make up the five largest unreached people groups in Yemen.



LIMITED RESOURCES

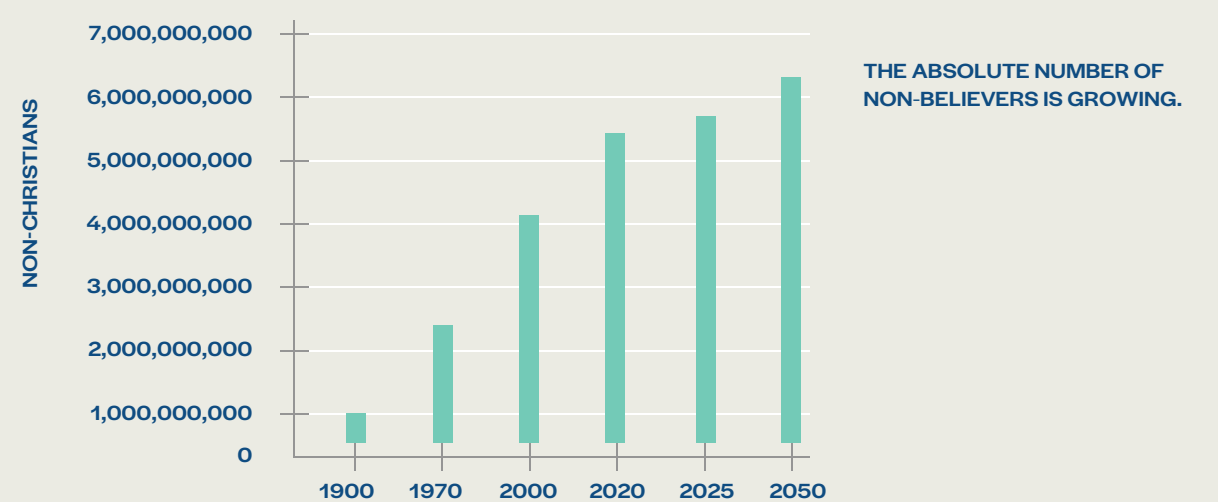
For every dollar of Christian giving to all causes less than one penny goes to financing pioneer church planting among unreached people groups.



North Americans spend about the same on Halloween costumes for pets as they do on outreach to unreached people groups.

An estimated \$53 billion (yes billion!) dollars is embezzled annually by custodians of Christian churches, organizations, and ministries worldwide. That is more than the amount that annually goes to global foreign missions.

LIMITED PROGRESS



There are more people alive today that do not know Christ than at any other time in history. Over 151,000 non-believers die every day.

While the 2.6% average annual growth rate (AAGR) of Evangelicals is faster than the general population growth rate of about 1.1%, the Evangelical growth rate has slowed since the mid-1990s.
