Representative **Norman K. Thurston** proposes the following amendments:

Page 1, Lines 15 through 16: {15 requires deposits into the restricted account of a percentage of the total gross **16** revenue from the sale of liquor; } Page 3, Lines 59 through 71: 59 (1) As used in this section {\displaystyle \displaystyle \dintaystyle \displaystyle \displaystyle \displaystyle \displaystyle \d 60 {(a)} "Department of Health" means the Department of Health created in Section 26-1-4. (b) "Restricted account" means the Drinking While Pregnant Prevention Media and {-61 **Education Campaign Restricted Account created in this section. 62** (2) (a) There is created a restricted account within the General Fund known as the 63 64 "Drinking While Pregnant Prevention Media and Education Campaign Restricted Account." 65 (b) The restricted account consists of: (i) deposits made under Subsection (3); and 66 (ii) interest earned on the restricted account. 67 (3) The department shall deposit 0.4% of the total gross revenue from sales of liquor {-68-**69** with the state treasurer, as determined by the total gross revenue collected for the fiscal year **70** two years preceding the fiscal year for which the deposit is made, to be credited to the restricted account and to be used by the Department of Health as provided in Section 26-7-10. 71
