## A BILL ENTITLED

## AN ORDINANCE concerning: Public Works - Utilities - Metered Water and Wastewater Charges

FOR the purpose of modifying metered water and wastewater charges; providing for the effective date of this Ordinance; and generally relating to utilities.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 13-5-805(b)
Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)
SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

## ARTICLE 13. PUBLIC WORKS

## TITLE 5. UTILITIES

## 13-5-805. Solid waste service charge. Metered water and wastewater charges.

(b) Charges. The charge for each 1,000 gallons of water usage is [[ $\$ 2.70]$ ] $\$ 3.23$ for water and [[\$4.74]] $\$ 5.67$ for wastewater. For the fiscal year beginning [[July 1, 2016]] JULY 1, 2024, and for each fiscal year thereafter, the County Executive shall set the charges for water and wastewater usage in accordance with § 4-11-105 of this Code and may

increase the charges in an amount not to exceed $5.00 \%$ of the then current charges. Any increase in charges in an amount greater than $5.00 \%$ shall be set by the County Council by ordinance. There is an account maintenance charge of $\$ 6.00$ per billing cycle regardless of the amount of usage.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
