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10 § 1-19-8.250.3. CHILD CARE CENTERS AS AN ACCESORY USE IN THE ORI DISTRICT.

- In the ORI zoning district, a child care center <u>may</u> [shall] be <u>an accessory</u> [a secondary] use
- 13 within a building utilized for a permitted use and the child care center shall not utilize more than
- 14 10% of the building floor area on the particular lot on which such child care center is located.

- 1 The minimum size of a child care center shall be determined based on the amount of square
- 2 footage required under the State of Maryland Code of Regulations 10.05.01. All recreational and
- 3 open space shall be in accordance with state regulations. Play areas provided must be fully
- 4 fenced.

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
