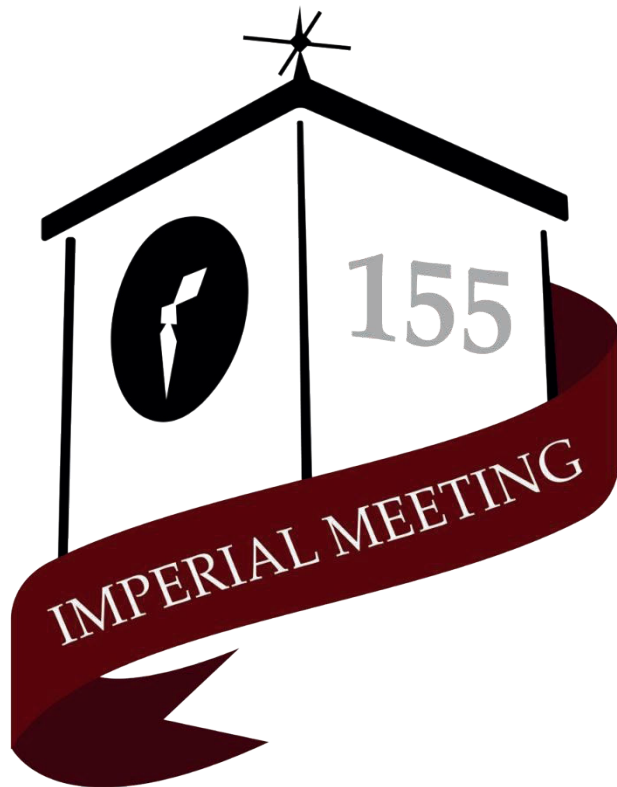

HISTORY OF THE IMPERIAL MEETING

In the late 1850s, due to a fear in Britain of a French invasion, units of Volunteers were raised throughout the country with the intention that every man be trained to shoot accurately and effectively “in defence of the Realm”. At that time it was considered, at the highest levels, a man’s patriotic duty to be able to shoot well in order to defend his country.



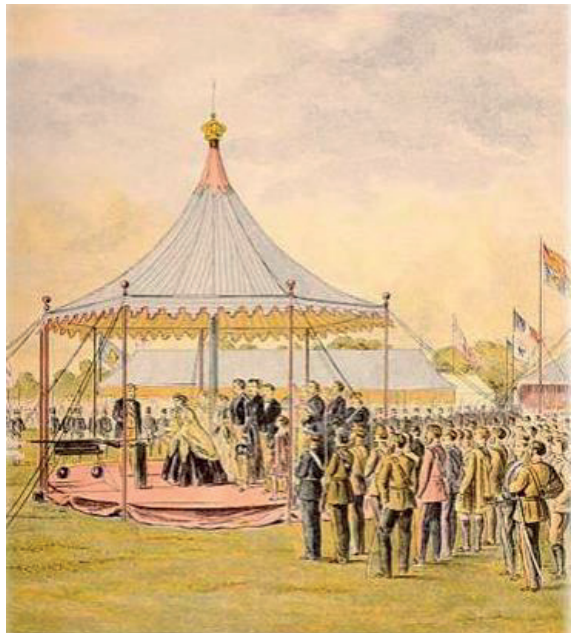
In 1859 influential persons within the Volunteer Movement encouraged the formation of a body to promote rifle shooting and subsequently the National Rifle Association (NRA) was formed.

The NRA would organise an annual Prize Meeting in which any Volunteer was eligible to enter and offered prizes for the improvement of firearms, their sighting or other matters relating to the science of gunnery.

The annual Prize Meeting, now known as the Imperial Meeting, has taken place annually excepting the duration of the two World Wars.

At the first Prize Meeting in July 1860, HM Queen Victoria offered a prize of £250 and fired the first shot of the Meeting. A leading engineer and ballistician, Mr Whitworth, set up one of his rifles (a .451” Whitworth Hexagonal by virtue of its hexagonal bore) in a mechanical rest at a distance of 400 yards from the iron target.

Her Majesty duly pulled the silken cord attached to the trigger, her shot striking the target about half an inch from the centre. Both the target and rifle are available to view in the NRA’s Museum.



In 1890 the NRA moved from Wimbledon Common to Bisley in Surrey. When the NRA moved to Bisley, so did its verandahed colonial bungalow. Soon afterwards, a young armoury sergeant called George Fulton took over the portion used as a workshop for £15 a year in rent.



George E Fulton started his shooting career in the Volunteers in the early 1880s and in 1888 he won the Queen's Prize.

He used the £250 prize to start the Fulton shop. He also went on to win the Grand Aggregate and St. George's.



His son, Arthur Fulton won the Sovereign's Prize three times - 1912, 1926 and 1931 as well as the King's Silver Medal on three occasions.

In 1959 he was awarded the MBE for his services to rifle shooting.



In 1958 Robin Fulton succeeded in carrying on the family tradition by winning the Queen's Prize. Collectively, the members of this firm have won no fewer than 5 King's or Queen's Gold Medals, 3 King's Silver Medals, 1 Grand Aggregate Gold Cross, 4 Silver Crosses and the St George's three times.

The Imperial is a Meeting of Meetings, and in addition to the Target Rifle competitions including HM The King's Prize, it now incorporates many disciplines of target shooting namely: Service Rifle, Military Adaptive, Schools and Cadets, Precision Snapshooting, 300m, Match Rifle, F Class, Gallery Rifle & Pistol, Classic & Historic and Civilian Service Rifle, attracting competitors from around the world.

The Elcho Shield



The match for the Elcho Shield arose from a challenge by Scotland to England in 1861. The terms of the challenge were established by Lord Elcho, who had determined to give a prize to the NRA's annual meeting at Wimbledon. He wished it to be a prize for annual competition as an encouragement to International Small-bore shooting (Match Rifle in early years), and also that his name might be perpetuated in connection with the Association and the volunteers.

Following years of deliberation and work to create the 6x3ft shield, it was first presented formally in 1865

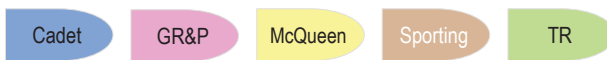

NRA MUSEUM

From the first days of the Association, members have generously donated a steady stream of artefacts, most of which were put into storage. Many of the historically important rifles and pistols form the core exhibits in the Museum as it is today.

The superb condition of the firearms is largely due to the care and attention of the late Dr LP Clarke, continued by NRA armourers post WWII. As well as caring for the collection, Dr Clarke as Editor kept the NRA Journal in production for several years virtually single-handed.

In 1974 Air Commodore Arthur Riall, the then Secretary of the Association, approached the late Mr NEC (Ted) Molyneux with a proposal that a proper organisational framework be formulated for the museum. An inventory and valuation followed. After careful consideration it was decided that the Museum's contents should only relate to the Association and not constitute a general collection of firearms.

The NRA has one of the finest collections of silver trophies in the country. Some of the largest pieces from the NRA's silver collection, including the impressive National Challenge Trophy and the China Cup, are housed in the Museum. There is a fine library and a picture gallery containing many watercolour paintings of scenes at Wimbledon.
