C-130J Maintenance and Aircrew **Training System**

The Lockheed Martin C-130J Maintenance and Aicrew Training System (MATS) program provides a comprehensive range of training devices and training support services including aircrew instruction, operations, contractor logistics support and engineering services. Located at Little Rock AFB, Arkansas, the schoolhouse is the DoD's formal C-130J aircrew and maintenance personnel training center for the U. S. Air Force. Graduates of the formal school are mission-qualified and can then report to operational units in the Air Mobility Command (AMC), Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC), and Air Nation Guard (ANG). Supported by the Main Operating Base (MOB) at Keesler AFB, Mississippi, C-130J continuation and refresher training is provided for all C-130J aircrews.

Lockheed Martin provides instruction for ground-based academic and simulator lessons. Training includes all crew positions and aircrew training courses. A full Training Systems Support Center (TSSC) provides operations and maintenance (O&M) and revision and maintenance (R&M) engineering tasks. The C-130J MATS contract also includes a security program, student publications library and learning center operation.
