THIS HELP LINE PROVIDES INFORMATION ON PURCHASING CONVERTERS BOXES, OBTAINING COUPONS AND OTHER BASIC INFORMATION. AN OPTION IS ALSO PROVIDED FOR THE CALLER TO LEAVE A MESSAGE FOR ONE-ON-ONE ENGINEERING ASSISTANCE. OUR SENIOR TRANSMITTER ENGINEERS MONITOR THIS HELP LINE FOR MESSAGES AND PERSONALLY RETURN THE CALLS.

WVBT-TV HAS AN ARRANGEMENT WITH TWO MEMBERS OF THE RADIO AMATEUR SOCIETY OF NORFOLK TO ACT AS VOLUNTEERS TO HELP AREA CITIZENS INSTALL CONVERTER BOXES AND ANTENNAS. AS OUR ENGINEERS TAKE CALLS, IF THEY FIND THAT THEY CAN NOT WALK THE VIEWER THROUGH THEIR DTV HOOK-UP ISSUES, THESE VOLUNTEERS WILL SERVE AS AN ADJUNT TO GO TO THE VIEWER'S HOME AND GIVE THEM ONE-ON-ONE ASSISTANCE. THIS PARTNERSHIP IS ON-GOING UNTIL AT LEAST JUNE 12, 2009.

ON MAY 21, 2009, WVBT-TV PARTICIPATED IN THE NATIONWIDE 5 MINUTE SHUT-OFF TESTS. WE DID SOFT SHUT-OFFS AT 7:25 - 7:30AM,

12:25 - 12:30PM, AND 6:25 - 6:30PM AS THE TESTS WERE HAPPENING, WE RAN A LOOPED VIDEO WITH SIMULATED COLOR BARS IN THE BACKGROUND AND SCROLLING INFORMATION THAT DIRECTING EFFECTED VIEWERS TO CONTACT 1-888-CALL-FCC OR WWW.DTV.GOV FOR FURTHER ASSISTANCE. SEVEN ENGINEERS PLUS 3 OTHER EMPLOYEES WERE ON HAND TO ANSWER ANY VIEWER PHONE CALLS DURING EACH SHUT-OFF TEST, BUT NO VIEWER CALLS WERE RECEIVED. THE TESTS WERE PROMOTED ON AIR STARTING MAY 20, 2009 AT 5:30 AM AND THROUGHOUT THE DAY UNTIL THE FINAL DTV SOFT TEST AT 6:25 PM. SPOT THAT STATIONS CAN RUN DURING THE TEST PERIOD. THE NEWS FEATURED A :30 FEATURE ON THE SHUT-OFF AT 10PM ON THE 20TH AND TWO PACKAGES IN THE 7AM NEWS SHOW ON THE 21ST.

ON JUNE 12, 2009, WVBT-TV SHUT OFF ITS ANALOG SIGNAL AND CONTINUED TO BROADCAST SOLELY IN DIGITAL.

ON FRIDAY, JUNE 12TH, THE DTV PHONE BANKS WERE OPEN FROM 8:30 A.M. TO 11:30 P.M. THE FOLLOWING ARE THE NUMBER PEOPLE AND DEPARTMENTS THAT MANNED THE PHONES: (7) PEOPLE FROM ENGINEERING, SALES, NEWS, PRODUCTION AND NEW MEDIA MANNED THE PHONES FRIDAY FROM 8:30 A.M.
