






- Formed in 1991 by the merger of Newmont Australia and BHP Gold Mines

### **Current 5 Year Production Profile**




### **Contract of Work**

## **Gosowong Goldfield**




- Approximately 6 million ounces discovered to date

   million over 5 years
- An option to purchase
   25% of the SCG's
   Tembang epithermal gold project for USD10 million

- Non-binding heads of agreement with Southern Arc Minerals
- Can earn a 63.75% interest in the project
