

Currency Returned to the Reserve Bank

Claim less than NZ\$5 and to be collected by customer in person

Use this form if you have old money that is no longer 'legal tender' that you wish to claim AND you wish to collect the currency from the Reserve Bank in person AND the amount claimed is NZ\$5 or less.

The RBNZ does not offer advice on the numismatic/rarity value of notes and coins and pays only the face value. Claimants should consult a dealer if they think the currency may have extra value.

Any foreign currency included in this claim will be donated to charity.

You can choose to receive payment into your bank account in which case you need to use a different form entitled 'Claims to Be Paid into Bank Account' which is available on the RBNZ's website. The payment of any claim greater than \$5 will be made into bank accounts only and not in person.

Any claims of \$1000 or more will need to be discussed with a Currency Officer and additional information may be requested. Please ensure you include a photocopy of a current form of photo ID such as driver's licence, passport, or firearms licence.
