AB 40 – Biennial Budget Bill (Passed 19-14)

NPCW Position – Oppose Bill

- Eliminate all State funding for Planned Parenthood.
- Limiting access to the Medicaid Family Planning Program.

AB 40, SA 3 – Amendment to restore Planned Parenthood Funding (Failed 19-14)

NPCW Position – Support Amendment

Restores funding of Planned Parenthood in the biennial budget bill.

SJR 28 – Honoring so-called Crisis Pregnancy Center (Passed 28-5)

NPCW Position – Oppose Resolution

Honors so-called Crisis Pregnancy Centers (CPCs). CPCs are the provider arm of the anti-choice movement. These centers often misrepresent themselves as legitimate health centers and use deception and scare tactics to prevent women from choosing abortion.

SJR 28, SSA 1 – Amendment honoring Comprehensive Health Centers (Failed 21-12)

NPCW Position – Support Amendment

Changes the language of SJR 28 to honor legitimate comprehensive women's health providers.

SB 237 – Repeal of the Healthy Youth Act (Passed 17-15)

NPCW Position – Oppose Bill

Repeals the Healthy Youth Act which requires that all sex education programs in Wisconsin be age-appropriate, medically accurate, and comprehensive, including information about both abstinence and contraceptives to prevent sexually transmitted disease and unintended pregnancy.

SB92 – Abortion Coverage Ban (Passed 17-16)

NPCW Position – Oppose Bill

Bans insurance coverage for abortion for all plans participating in Affordable Care Act exchanges, even when a woman is paying for coverage entirely with her own money.

SB 306 – Abortion Restrictions (Passed 17 – 15)

NPCW Position – Oppose Bill

Adds new abortion restrictions including scripted counseling requirements, banning telemedicine, legislating which physician a woman must see for follow-up, and adding felony penalties for abortion physicians.
