## Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 773 likely voters in Nevada. The poll was conducted from October $24^{\text {th }}$ through the $26^{\text {th }}$, with a margin of error of $\pm 3.5 \%$. The totals may not round to $100 \%$ because of rounding. The survey was conducted using live agents and an online panel of cell phone users. The results are weighted by voting demographics. The poll was Paid for by Gravis Marketing.
