Coastal Treatment Plant Export Sludge Force Main Replacement

Public Scoping Meeting

The South Orange County Wastewater Authority (SOCWA) will be the lead agency and will prepare an environmental impact report (EIR) for the Coastal Treatment Plant Export Sludge Force Main Replacement project. The sludge force main is an existing set of two parallel pipelines that run approximately 4.5 miles from SOCWA's Coastal Treatment Plant (CTP), north along the eastern side of Aliso Creek to Alicia Parkway, continuing through Laguna Niguel Regional Park to SOCWA's Regional Treatment Plant (RTP). The pipeline to be replaced includes the portion between the CTP and Alicia Parkway. The proposed project is located within the County of Orange Aliso and Woods Canyons Wilderness Park.

A public scoping meeting will be held to give the public an opportunity to receive more information on the proposed project, to provide comments and suggestions on the scope of the EIR, and to offer input regarding potential alternatives. The address, date, and time of this meeting are as follows:
