# HOW DID WE SCORE OUR LEGISLATORS

#### **FLOOR VOTES:**

Points are awarded to legislators for final floor votes that supported MCA's position. Points are listed in each bill column header, and are based on the level of importance each bill had to the MCA's efforts in the legislature. Five is the greatest number of points allotted to any bill. No points are awarded or deducted for votes against MCA's position. Votes for which a legislator is excused or absent are not factored into the final score, so they do affect the legislator's final score.

#### **BILL SPONSOR POINTS:**

Five points are awarded to legislators who sponsor selected MCA-supported bills or pro-business bills.

#### **SCORE FORMULA:**

Final floor vote points earned

- + Sponsor points / Possible final floor vote points
- = MCA score

In order to provide an accurate picture of legislators' performance in relation to the MCA's legislative focus, we provided each legislator's overall score for the 2017 legislative session along with their "lifetime average" going back four sessions.

# **KEY LEGISLATION FOR MCA**

**HB 8** (Keane, D-Butte) — Dedicated to renewable resource bonds and loans, this bill was extremely important to members of the MCA. We scored this bill at 5 possible points. Unfortunately, the bill died in the final hours of the session.

**HB 473** (Garner, R-Kalispell) — This bill provided much-needed revisions to highway revenue laws, including a gas tax. We scored the bill at 5 possible points, and are pleased to note the bill passed, raising the gas tax to help pay for highways, roads, and bridges for the first time in 25 years.

**HB 645** (Cuffe, R-Eureka) — This was one of two competing bills designed to approve bonding for infrastructure projects around the state, setting it at a score of 5 possible points from the MCA. The bill died in the final hours of the session.

**SB 367** (Moore, R-Miles City) — This bill, with an MCA score of 5 possible points, was the other bill introduced for the purpose of approving bonding for infrastructure projects around the state, including \$30 million for the Quality Schools Facility Grant.
