Introduction

Our Environmental Law Sub-committee welcomes the opportunity to respond to the Scottish Government's consultation on *A National Mission with Local Impact - draft infrastructure investment plan 2021-2022 to 2025-2026*¹. We have the following comments to put forward for consideration.

General comments

We note the proposals in relation to amending the definition of 'infrastructure' to include 'natural infrastructure' and support this in the context of this plan (i.e. infrastructure investment). We consider, however, that careful consideration would be required if 'natural infrastructure' is to be included in the definition of 'infrastructure' used in a wider context to ensure that unintended consequences are not created, including the potential for overlaps between funding sources.

In relation to assessing the carbon impact of future Infrastructure Investment Plans, we consider that the suggested approach is proportionate.
